






Dashboard on Social & Economic Statistics: A Case study in Mukim Ayer Hitam, Muar, Johor, Malaysia










- . A case study of **self-updating on basic information of living quarters (LQ) and the population** was held in Mukim Ayer Hitam, Johor, Malaysia starting in June 2022.
- ii. It consists of 22 Enumeration Blocks, 2,705 **geocode of each LQs,** 6,798 person and 150 of **establishments with geocode.**



- iii. This Dashboard also is integrated with the other basic facilities such as school, hospital/ clinic, homestay and natural disaster area (potential area of floods.)
- iv. This case study is the collaboration between the Department of Statistics Malaysia and District office of Muar, Johor, Malaysia.
- v. This case study also has been implemented to the other district or locality for each state in Malaysia as one of the input for the development of Malaysia Statistical Address register (MSAR) and Malaysia Statistical Population Profile (MSPP).
