- Draws on the <u>Disability Data Advocacy Toolkit</u>
- Is an open-source workshop materials aim to introduce the basic concepts and skills on disability data in the local context and is available in English and Spanish

Case Studies with OPD-led data efforts to show the importance of citizengenerated data to complement official statistics.

- For example, Las Piñas Persons with Disability Federation, Inc. and Women with Disabilities Leap for Economic and Social Progress led a <u>project of citizen-generated data collection</u> in Las Piñas, Philippines.
- The data profiling project is now being promoted and with the appropriate funds, will be replicated nationwide.

## Inclusive data and persons with disabilities: Disability Data Initiative

- We are working with Fordham University's <u>Disability Data Initiative</u> (DDI) to make the internationally comparable data on disability understandable and usable for organizations of persons with disabilities at national and subnational levels.
- The DDI's mission is to provide analyses of disability data to help advance the rights of persons with disabilities and sustainable development for all.
- The DDI makes internationally comparable data on disability publicly available and accessible.
- Each year, DDI produces reports with summaries in Easy Read, Chinese, English, French, Russian, and Spanish.
