UN international demographic data collection

- Based on sending a set of questionnaires to national statistics authorities
- The major vehicle for dissemination of population and vital statistics is the UN Demographic Yearbook (DYB) both in print and electronic

International comparability depends on:


- Completeness and accuracy of data

- Figures coming different types of sources




How complete are the data sent from countries?



Percentage of countries that sent data to UNSD in the last five years




- Live births by sex and urban/rural residence



Availability and quality of VS





Coverage of birth registration








Civil registration coverage worldwide
