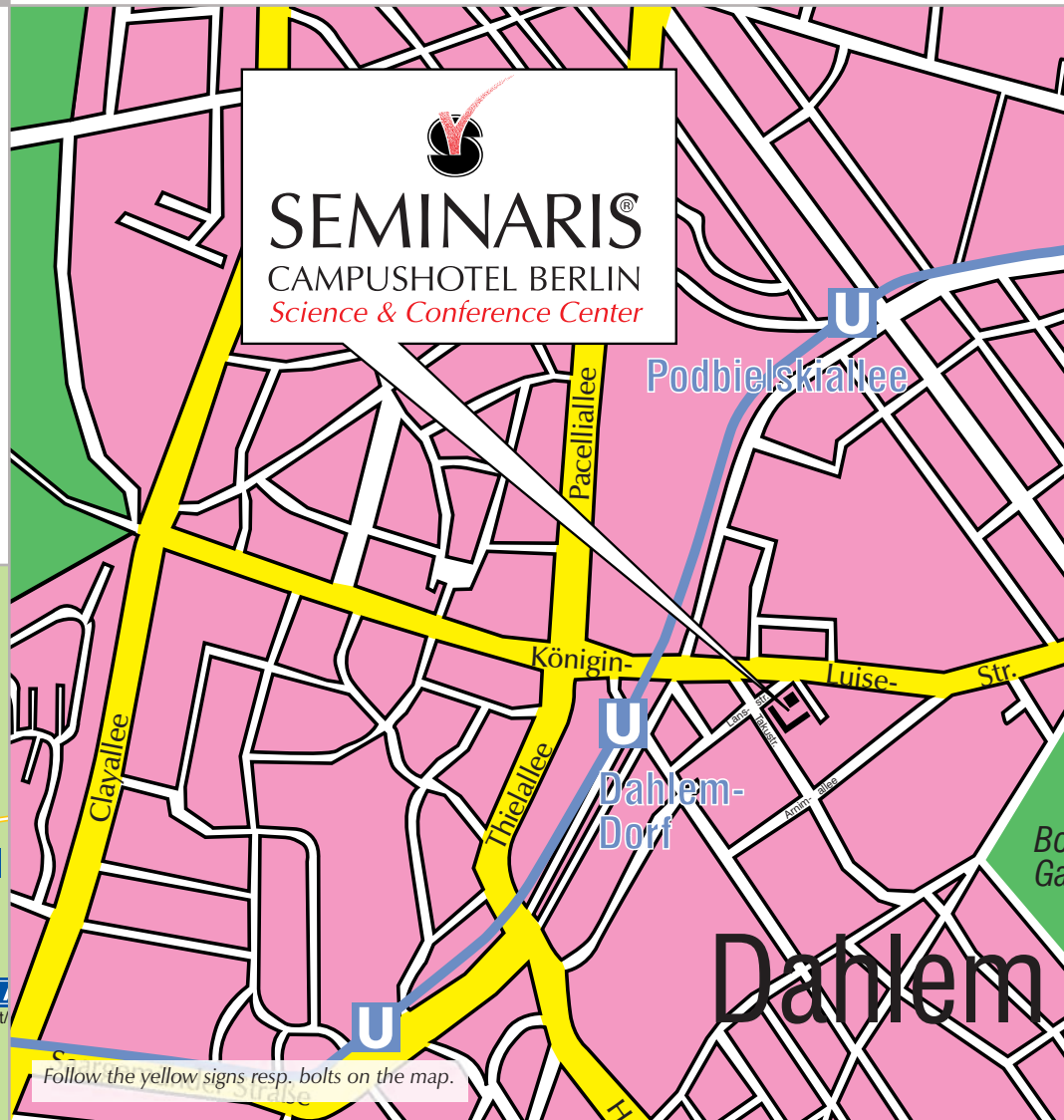

From the West: A 2 / A 10 / A 115 direction Potsdam/Berlin / AS 4 Zehlendorf / B1 Potsdamer Chaussee / turn left Clayallee / right Königin-Luise-Str. / right into Takustraße / Lansstraße.

From the South: via A 103 / AS 5 Schloßstraße to the B1, Unter den Eichen, turn right into Fabekstraße then Lansstraße. From the East: via A 12 / A 10 / A 113 direction airport Berlin-Brandenburg Willy Brandt / A 100 / A 103 / AS 5 Wolfensteindamm, turn right into Schloßstraße direction Dahlem / left into Grunewaldstraße / left into Königin-Luise-Straße / left into Lansstraße.

Railway: Berlin Central Station (ICE, IC-, RE- and RB-Station), S-Bahn to Zoologischer Garten, then take U2 to Wittenbergplatz, from there U3 to "Dahlem Dorf".

Airport: International airport Berlin-Brandenburg Willy Brandt 22 km.
