Statistical work programme	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The expected accomplishments of the 2008-2009 biennial Statistics subprogramme are (i) increased national capacity in Asia and the Pacific, particularly the least developed countries, to provide data required for measuring progress towards achieving internationally agreed development goals, (ii) increased access to comparable development and short-term indicators for policy makers, the development community and the public at large, and (iii) increased knowledge and understanding of key national and regional socio-economic trends, especially progress towards the Millennium Development Goals, by national official statisticians and policymakers in the Asia and Pacific region
