ISSUES RELATED TO WORK OF THE TASK FORCES

Report of the Inter-agency Task Force on Environment Statistics

Report prepared by the United Nations Statistical Division

The Statistical Commission, at its special session (11-15 April 1994), requested the Task Force, in order to aid the coordination task across agencies, to compile a description of the different programmes and activities carried out in the areas of environmental statistics, indicators and accounting, showing the agencies involved, time-frames, progress, plans and resource constraints. In addition, the Commission recommended that the Task Force draw up an action-oriented work programme based on specific coordination requirements.

The United Nations Statistical Division (UNSTAT), as convener of the Task Force, will circulate to all members of the Task Force a synopsis of plans and activities with a request to add to or correct the information provided. In order to draw up the work programme, it would be desirable to organize a meeting of the Task Force. We will propose to members of the Task Force to hold such a meeting in New York in September 1994 which would allow enough time for submitting in writing the results to the twenty-eighth session of the Statistical Commission.
