## PALESTININ EXPERIENCE IN APPLICATION OF TUS

Introduction

In Palestine, TUS is planned every 10 years.

Palestine implemented the 1<sup>st</sup> National TUS in 1999/2000.

Planning to implement the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round 2012/2013

National representative survey.

Carried out independently.

Used mainly in the **social sector**, for gender statistics

In addition to the Gender Statistics is planned to be more focus on

- Provide information with a gender approach
- Paid and unpaid work and personal activities of the population

• Establishment of satellite accounts

**Population:** All Palestinian age 10 yrs+ living in the Palestinian territory, excluding persons living in institutions such as prisoners, shelters,...

## Number of diary days: One diary day

# **Coverage of the year**

The survey days/dates were representative of, and cover a full 12 months period. The diary day was allocated to individuals by a controlled random procedure. (two individuals: Male and Female

### **Three harmonized Survey Tools:**

*Household Questionnaire*: Face to face Interview with paper questionnaire

*Individual questionnaire*: Face to face Interview with paper questionnaire

The Day Diary: Self-administered paper questionnaires

### **Classification System and Coding rules**

1<sup>st</sup> Round: The daily diary starts at <u>12:00 am</u> and covers 24 hours with <u>84</u> intervals of <u>15</u> minutes during the day and <u>30</u> minutes after midnight. (*when, what, Is paid or not, where, with whom*)

2<sup>nd</sup> Round: The daily diary <u>starts at 12:00 am</u> and covers 24 hours <u>with</u> <u>120 intervals</u> of <u>10 minutes during the day and <u>30 minutes after</u> midnight. (*when, what, what else, where, with whom*)</u>

# **Coding the Day Diary:**

1<sup>st</sup> Round: The respondents describe <u>only one main activity</u> performed within per interval (asked to give as much as he could of details about this activity)

2<sup>nd</sup> Round: The respondents will be asked to describe the main two activities performed (will be asked to give as much as he could of details about this activity) main activity and secondary activity at the same period

The coding process translates the sentences reported by the interviewed into codes (encoded)

*First level is always present*(*Hierarchical*) :  $\Rightarrow$  (*Three levls*): *are just specifications of the first level's categories* 

#### **Classification System**

1<sup>st</sup> Round: proposed by ICTUS 1997,  $\Rightarrow$  adapted to the national needs  $\Rightarrow$  International comparability.

 $2^{nd}$  Round: proposed by ICTUS 2012,  $\Rightarrow$  adapted to the national needs  $\Rightarrow$  International comparability.
