  - Published in 2001 as one of the outputs of the CIDA funded Project on the Development of a Methodology to Generate Statistics on Violence against Women and Children
- 3. Glossary on Violence against Women and Other Related Concepts (for Statistical Purposes)
  - Published in May 2001 as one of the outputs of the CIDA funded project on VAWC
- 4. Refinement of the Existing Gender and Development (GAD) Indicator System
  - Published in May 2001 as one of the outputs of the CIDA funded project on the Refinement of Existing GAD Indicator System
- 5. Other short publications of 1-5 pages: (1) Statistics Series featuring historical trends on specific topics, e.g. rape cases; (2) Factsheets featuring key indicators on various sectors

## II. NSCB Sub-National Office: Regional Divisions (RD)

  - a) RD 1 Ilocos Region: First edition released in 2000 and in 2001, with funding assistance from NCRFW-CIDA ISP II thru NEDA Regional Office; succeeding editions in 2002, 2003 and 2005 funded from regular budget of NSCB. Also available in CD-ROM;
  - b) RD 4 Southern Tagalog Region: Being a newly established RD of NSCB, came out with 2 publications of the WAM for Region IV-A and region IV-B in 2006, funds from NSCB regular budget;
  - c) RD 5 Bicol Region: Released first issue of the WAM in 2000, funded by the Commission on Population (regional office); second edition released in 2003 with funding assistance from the provincial government of Albay province (LGU);
  - d) RD 6 Western Visayas Region: Released first issue of the WAM in 2000, with special feature on "The Women in the Service Sector in Iloilo City", a study conducted by the Western Visayas State University in collaboration with the NSCB RD 6; second edition released in 2002 with additional chapter on Girls and Boys; third edition released in 2003 featuring a special study on women, "Domestic

- violence in the Province of Aklan"; fourth edition released in 2005, with special study on women, "Leisure Time Allocation Among Women: Some Evidence in Iloilo City, Philippines";
- e) RD 8 Eastern Visayas Region: Maiden issue launched and published in 2001 with funding assistance from CIDA ISP II thru the NEDA Regional Office; second edition released in 2005 (also in CD-ROM version);
- f) RD 9 –Western Mindanao Region: released first issue in 1994; released updates on an annual basis (?) with the cover of the 1998 edition, funded by the Regional office of the Commission on Population; funded from regular budget of NSCB;
- g) RD 10 Northern Mindanao (Another newly reconstituted RD): 2006 edition now being finalized for printing; budgeted from NSCB regular budget;
- h) RD11 Southern Mindanao Region: Maiden issue launched in 2000 with funding assistance form the Ford Foundation; second edition of "Women and Men in Davao Region" released in 2005 and jointly funded by the Ateneo Mindanao Working Group on Gender Reproductive Health and Sexuality, and the Development of Peoples Foundation (both are NGOs); and
- RD 12 CentralMindanao Region: Maiden issue released in 1999 with funding assistance from CIDA; 2003 issue not printed due to budget limitations; and 2005 edition released in 2005 sourced from NSCB regular funds.

The NSCB RDs also regularly produce short-based publications: Statseries and Genderwatch featuring key gender statistics at the sub-national levels.
