INFORMATION NOTE FOR PARTICIPANTS

GENERAL

The United Nations Regional Workshop on CensusInfo will be held from 15 to 18 May 2012 in Almaty, Kazakhstan. The Workshop is co-organized by the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD) and the Agency of Statistics of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

VENUE

The Workshop will take place at the Holiday Inn Hotel, located at 2d Timiyazev Street, Almaty, 050013 Kazakhstan, Tel (7-727) 2440255, Fax (7-727) 2440277, Email <u>alakz@ihg.com</u>, Web <u>http://www.holidayinn.com/hotels/us/en/almaty/alakz/hoteldetail</u>. All sessions of the Workshop will be held in a section of the **Aport Ballroom**.

REGISTRATION OF PARTICIPANTS

Registration of participants will be conducted on Tuesday, 15 May 2012, between 9.00 and 9.30 a.m. in the hall outside the conference room.

OPENING SESSION

The Workshop will be opened at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, 15 May 2012.

LANGUAGE

The Workshop will be conducted in English with simultaneous interpretation provided in Russian.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

All foreign participants must hold passports that are valid for at least six months. Holders of passport issued by any of the countries belonging to the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS)—except Turkmenistan—are not required to obtain entry visas for Kazakhstan. Participants from countries not covered by bilateral agreements on visas with the Republic of Kazakhstan are required to obtain appropriate entry visa. To obtain a visa of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the participants should apply to a diplomatic/consular mission of the Republic of Kazakhstan in their country of residence. The visa application should be submitted together with the official invitation letter, which is generally sufficient to be used as supporting documentation for visa

application. Since the processing of visa and its issuance will take considerable time, participants are urged to pay priority attention to this matter. Participants anticipating difficulty in obtaining visa to Kazakhstan are requested to contact the organizers of the Workshop. If necessary, the United Nations can assist by sending a letter addressed to the nearest Kazakh diplomatic mission.

Participants are urged to check the latest information regarding visa requirements applying to their citizenship with the nearest Kazakh diplomatic mission. A list of Kazakh diplomatic missions may be found on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs at

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Participants are individually responsible for arranging their own accommodations. However, special hotel accommodation rates have been obtained from two hotels: Kazzhol Hotel and Holiday Inn. Participants interested in staying at any of these two hotels should fill out the respective registration form (attached) and directly contact the hotel to book their accommodations. The contact addresses of the hotels are provided in the registration forms.

Almaty has accommodations in every budget category. For more options on hotel accommodations please consult the official website of the Ministry of Tourism and Sports <<u>http://visitkazakhstan.kz/</u>>.

Each participant is individually responsible for the payment of his/her own accommodation. Before departing from Almaty, participants are expected to settle directly with their hotel all accounts, including room charges and other expenses, such as local and long-distance telephone calls, Internet use, business centre use, laundry, room service, hotel transportation services as well as mini-bar items and restaurant and bar services. Participants may also be responsible for any charges incurred with respect to rooms remaining vacant owing to late arrival or rescheduled departure for which inadequate prior notice is given. All payments must be settled by Cash or Credit Card by the participants at the time of their departure from their respective hotels.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

For participants whose travel is funded by UNSD, the UNDP office in the home country of the participant will be authorized to issue the most direct economy roundtrip air ticket, aiming to arrive at Almaty, as far as possible, on Monday, 14 May and departing from Almaty on Saturday, 19 May 2012. Sponsored participants are kindly requested to contact the UNDP office in their respective countries regarding their tickets only after they receive a notice of travel authorization from UNSD.

TRANSPORTATION UPON ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Participants are responsible for arranging their own transportation to/from the airport as well as between their hotel and the Workshop venue. The Workshop organizers will not provide transportation to/from the airport.

Taxi is the best transport to use from the airport to the city center. There are two types of taxis: licensed taxis (with "taxi" label painted on the side of the vehicle) and informal taxis (privately owned vehicles without a "taxi" label). The safest means of transport is by licensed taxi which can be booked at the counters located in the waiting area inside the airport or through the uniformed dispatchers who may be found at the arrival gate of the airport.

The following licensed taxi companies are represented at the airport: Almaty Taxi (+7-727-2555-333); Mega Taxi (+7-727-233-3111); Elite Taxi (+7-727-278-0333); and, Komandir Taxi (+7-727-390-0500). If you go with one of these licensed taxis, expect to pay approximately between 2,700 KZT and 4,000 KZT (or from about 18 USD to 27 USD), one way, from the airport to a hotel in the city center.

If you decide to go with informal taxi (private vehicle without a "taxi" sign/label) make sure to agree on a fixed price before you get into the vehicle or allow the driver to handle your luggage. The amount you pay will depend on your negotiating skills and how well you speak Russian or Kazakh. It may be necessary to have the exact amount of the fare in hand just in case the taxi driver does not have enough change. Alternatively, participants can arrange an airport pickup service directly from the hotel they are taking accommodations.

The Almaty International Airport is about 15 km from the city centre, where most of the hotels are located. It takes around 30 minutes to/from the airport to the city center. Information on the Almaty International Airport is available at: <u>http://en.alaport.com/main.html</u>

FOREIGN EXCHANGE

The local currency in Kazakhstan is the Tenge (KZT). Foreign currencies and traveller's cheques can be exchanged at authorized local banks and foreign exchange bureaus without restriction. The current rate of exchange against the United States dollar is approximately KZT 148 (www.xe.com; as of 11 April 2012). Please note that this rate is subject to change.

Most banks in Almaty are open from 0900 to 1800 hours, Monday through Friday. Major international credit cards including Visa and MasterCard are accepted in the larger hotels in Almaty and in major department stores, restaurants and supermarkets. Small businesses and family-run stores may not accept credit cards, so it is useful to keep a moderate amount of cash on hand.

TIME AND WEATHER

Almaty time is six hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+6).

Almaty has continental climate, with very warm summers and very cold winters. In the month of May, the weather in Almaty can be expected to be cool and comfortable, with the temperature averaging from 10 to 20 °C (or 50 to 70 °F). ELECTRICITY

The electricity voltage in Kazakhstan is 220 volts; the frequency is 50 Hz. Plug adaptors may be necessary to operate electrical appliances.

GENERAL INFORMATION ON ALMATY

The former capital and presently the largest city in Kazakhstan, Almaty is ethnically and culturally diverse. The city is located in the heart of the Eurasian continent, in the extreme south-east of the country, and at the foothills of the Tien Shan mountains. Sitting at an elevation of 700 to 1100 meters above sea level, Almaty has a continental climate, with large temperature fluctuations. A city of 1.5 million people, Almaty is believed to be the origin of the apple fruit. Located at what was then a transit station on the historical Silk Road, Almaty is a green city with wide streets, beautiful buildings, numerous parks, gardens and fountains. Although the capital of Kazakhstan has been moved to Astana, Almaty remains a scientific, cultural, historical, financial and industrial center.
