The purpose of this questionnaire is to collect, in a uniform manner, census data on the economically active and not economically active population, for inclusion in the United Nations Demographic Yearbook and other statistical publications and technical studies of the United Nations. Tabulations requested by this questionnaire are in agreement with the Principles and Recommendations for Population and Housing Censuses, Revision 1 (United Nations publication, sales no.E.98.XVII.8). This questionnaire requests enumerated census data (not estimates) and is therefore be sent to countries only when it is known that they have completed a population census.

Before starting to fill the tables, please read these instructions carefully.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE QUESTIONNAIRE

A. General instructions

1. In filling in the questionnaire, the following procedures are suggested:

- a. Give all figures unrounded, in units rather than thousands
- b. Use the following symbols in tables:

- when figure is zero
- .. when data are not available
- * when data are provisional

- c. Compare all tables to ensure that figures for identical items in different tables agree.
If there are differences between tables, explain in notes.

3. The data supplied should relate to the most recent census of population for which tabulations are available. Please provide the date of the census in the space indicated in each table. If some of the tabulation asked for are not yet available, please specify on the respective table the approximate date for the completion of such tabulations.

4. If it is not possible to supply figures classified or defined exactly as indicated in the tables, please provide the available data closest to the classification requested, making the necessary alterations in

column headings or stubs (please indicate these changes by using different colours). Also, make as many notes as necessary to explain special characteristics of the data or discrepancies with respect to categories specified in the tables. Do not hesitate inserting as many rows as needed for this purpose or adding as many pages as necessary.

B. Specific instructions

1. Groups included in the economically active population (Table 1 and 3-8)

If any of the following groups are not considered economically active in the national tabulations, please indicate how they are classified:

- (1) contributing (unpaid) family workers;
- (2) unemployed persons including those never previously employed;
- (3) armed forces;
- (4) part-time workers even though they may spend most time at non-gainful activities;
- (5) domestic servants.

2. Groups included in the non-economically active population (Table 1 and 2)

If any of the following are excluded in the national tabulations of the population not economically active, please indicate briefly how they are classified:

- (1) Homemakers, i.e. persons of either sex, not classified as economically active, who are engaged in household duties in their own home, for example, housewives and other relatives responsible for the care of the home and children.
- (2) Students, persons of either sex, not classified as economically active, who attend any regular educational institution, public or private, for systematic instruction at any level of education;
- (3) Pension or capital income recipients, i.e. persons of either sex, not economically active, who receive income from property or investments, interests, rents, royalties or pensions from former activities;
- (4) Others, i.e. persons of either sex, not classified as economically active, who are receiving public aid or private support, and all other persons not falling into any of the above three categories, like children not attending school.

3. Unemployed (Tables 1 and 3-8)

The total number of unemployed persons, including those with previous work experience and those looking for work for the first time should be given in Table 1. In the other tables, the unemployed with previous work experience should be included in the active population and classified according to their economic characteristics (i.e. industry, occupation, status) in their usual or last employment. Unemployed persons who have not previously been employed should also be included in the active population and shown under heading "Unemployed".

4. Age classification (Tables 1-5 and 8)

The age definition desired is "age at last birthday" or completed years. If age definition is not age at last birthday but is given in other terms (such as age at nearest birthday or difference between year of birth and year of census) please explain definition. If it is not possible to supply data for detailed age groups shown in the tables, the nearest age groups may be given; in this case, please make necessary changes in the stub, using different colours. Please indicate the method used if "age not stated" has been distributed. If any person under age 15 is included in the economically active population, please indicate (in the tables) the lower age limit.

5. Industry classification (Tables 3 and 6)

The industry groups shown are major divisions of the International Standard Classification of All Economic Activities, Third Revision, (ISIC), United Nations publication, sales no. E.90.XVII.11. If it is not possible to provide data for these divisions, please provide the next available industry group.

If the tabulations are only available using the ISIC, Rev. 2, United Nations publication, sales no. E.68.XVII.8, please fill tables 3A and 6A at the end of this questionnaire.

6. Occupation classification (Tables 4, 4.1, and 7)

The occupational groups shown are consistent with the International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO-88). If it is not possible to provide data for these groups, please provide data for the next occupational group. Further, in case of Table 4.1, if it is not possible to provide data by age groups, the figures for all ages by sex may be provided.

If the tabulations are only available using the ISCO-68, please fill tables 4A, 4.1A and 7A at the end of this questionnaire.

7. Status in employment classification (Tables 5, 6 and 7)

If any groups are identified in the national classification by status in employment which cannot be allocated in their entirety to one of the status categories shown in the table, please indicate what such groups are and supply figures for them.
