GDP: USD 4.2 thous.\$ (2015)





## Coal Mining in Mongolia




Coal statistics usually include primary (hard coal and lignite) and derived fuels.

#### DATA COLLECTION AND PROCESSING



#### **Processing and data validation**

Verification includes logical, range, variance and consistency checks

Validation edits

 to check the validity of basic identification of classificatory items in unit data

Logical edits

 ensure that two or more data items do not have contradictory values.

Consistency edits

• check to ensure that precise and correct arithmetic relationships exist between two or more data items.

Range edits

• identify whether or not a data item value falls inside a determined acceptable range.

Variance edits

• involve looking for suspiciously high variances at the output edit stage.
