

Country report for Norway London Group meeting 5-7 November 2003

In 1997, Statistics Norway started the NOREEA-project (The *NOR* wegian *E* conomic and *E* nvironmental *A* ccounts Project), which has received financing from Eurostat and the Norwegian Ministry of the Environment. The NOREEA-project is a joint project between the Division for National Accounts and the Division for Environment Statistics, concerning the development of integrated environmental and economic accounts.

Established Environmental and Economic Accounts areas:

- NAMEA air emission
 Annually publications incl. decoupling analyses (1991-2002)
- NAMEA solid waste Annually publications (1993-2001)
- Industries' environmental protection expenditures and investments Annually publications (2000-2001)
- Asset accounts for oil and gas Annually reporting to Eurostat (1980-2002)

Recent pilot studies/work in progress:

- Expenditures for water and wastewater by municipal governments (2001)
- Expenditures for solid waste by municipal governments (2001)
- Developing statistics for central government environmental protection expenditures according to CEPA definitions (2001)
- NAMEA for emissions to water
- Extend NAMEA for air emissions to include energy use
- Energy taxes by industry (1999). Eurostat report together with Denmark, Sweden and Finland.
