The site presents the official MDG data along with definitions, methodologies and sources for the 48 indicators that measure progress towards the Millennium Development Goals.

UNSD collects energy statistics from more than 190 countries and updates and maintains the Energy Statistics Database which contains comprehensive energy statistics on more than 215 countries, regions and areas for production, trade and consumption of energy.

**United Nations Common Database**

Population size/year, population growth, motor vehicles in use, GDP/year, GDP growth, GDP per capita figures are from the Common Database. The UN Common Database (UNCDB) for statistics, maintained by UNSD, is a wide-ranging database which covers all countries and areas and includes data from more than 30 specialized international data sources. It is a compilation of United Nations and other specialist agency statistics, covering economic, social, financial and development topics.
