INFORMATION REGARDING GENERAL ARRANGEMENTS OF
IMMEDIATE INTEREST TO THE PARTICIPANTS

1. The United Nations Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names convened in accordance with a decision made by the Economic and Social Council at its 1385th meeting on 16 July 1965, will be held in Geneva, Switzerland, from 4 to 22 September 1967.
2. Participants are requested to refer to the United Nations publication entitled: United Nations Technical Conference on the International Map of the World on the Millionth Scale, held 3 to 22 August 1962, Bonn, Federal Republic of Germany, Volume I, pages 11 to 14,^{1/} for the rules of procedure which may be adopted by the Conference.
3. Mr. Horacio M. Ureta has been appointed by the Department of Economic and Social Affairs of the United Nations to serve as Executive Secretary for the Conference. Mr. Chris N. Christopher of the Cartography Section, Resources and Transport Division, of the United Nations Secretariat will serve as Deputy Executive Secretary.
