This paper lists all English-language exonyms\* that were deleted, changed, or added to the Foreign Place Names File of the U.S. Board on Geographic Names (BGN) since 1988. All other BGN-approved English-language exonyms are listed in the publication Gazetteer of Conventional Names, third edition, August 1988, published by the Defense Mapping Agency, Washington, DC.

All non-Roman-script endonyms\* in the list have been romanized by means of romanization systems approved jointly by BGN and the United Kingdom's Permanent Committee on Geographical Names for British Official Use (PCGN). Romanized endonyms are identified by means of an asterisk preceding the name. A question mark shown in place of a name in the "new endonym" column indicates that the name is not shown because official documentation for the name in the local language has not yet been acquired. The following abbreviation will be encountered in the "old endonym" column in the Added Exonyms section:

#### A.S.S.R. = Avtonomnaya Sovetskaya Sotsialisticheskaya Respublika

It should be noted that BGN does not use the terms "exonym" and "endonym" in its own work, preferring, instead, to use the terms "conventional name," "provisional name," and "local official name." A conventional name is defined as a name approved by BGN for use in addition to, or in lieu of, a BGN-approved local official name or names. A provisional name is an English-language name that has been found in an English-language source or derived from a romanized non-English form and is specified for use only because a BGN-approved local official name is not yet available. Examples of provisional names are Abkhazia, Adygea, and Ajaria. From the foregoing definitions, it can be seen that conventional and provisional names fit neatly into the category of exonyms and that local official names are, in fact, endonyms.

BGN will continue to monitor its holdings of exonyms, with a view toward making any necessary deletions, changes, or additions, as circumstances require.

<sup>\*</sup> An exonym is defined by UNGEGN as a geographical name used in a certain language for a geographical entity situated outside the area where that language has official status and differing in its form from the name used in the official language or languages of the area where the geographical entity is situated. An endonym, conversely, is a geographical name used in a certain language for a geographical entity situated within the area where that language has official status.
