Toponymy training to be held in Indonesia


Summary**

To build the capacity and skills of Government officials at the central and local levels and to increase toponymic activities at the national and international levels, international cooperation with regard to the standardization of geographical names will be stepped up. A fourth international training session on toponymy will be conducted in Yogyakarta, Indonesia, from 17 to 21 September 2012, in cooperation with the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names. The participants will include local government officials and representatives of countries in the Asia South-East and the Pacific South-West Division.
