## **Activity of the French-speaking Division**

## Summary\*\*

Since the last session of the Group of Experts on Geographical Names (UNGEGN), the French-speaking Division's activity has been based mainly on its work programme, which includes:

- (a) Information-gathering, chiefly for the French exonyms database "Le tour du monde en français" ("Around the world in French");
- (b) Information dissemination, through the Division's website and the publication of a new toponymic newsletter, the *Bulletin d'information toponymique*;
- (c) Support for research and training, in particular through the holding of a symposium in France.

In addition, the French-speaking Division has sought to link together UNGEGN and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization in efforts to have geographical names recognized as part of the cultural heritage of nations. The Division has also begun reviewing the French content of the search site for resolutions of the United Nations Conferences on the Standardization of Geographical Names in French, a site set up by the UNGEGN Working Group on Evaluation and Implementation.
