Report of Brazil

Summary**

The report provides a description of the actions taken by Brazil since the Ninth United Nations Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names as part of its efforts to standardize its set of geographical names. In the report, information is provided on:

(a) Participation of Brazil in national and international conferences and congresses;

(b) Launch of the concise Portuguese-language version of the Glossary of Terms for the Standardization of Geographical Names;

(c) Websites of the Portuguese-speaking Division and the Geographical Names Database of Brazil;

(d) Contribution to the World Geographical Names Database maintained by the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names;

(e) Launch of a glossary of generic terminology and a gazetteer of geographical names;

- (f) Current status of the Geographical Names Database of Brazil;
- (g) Training courses in Brazil;
