THE IMPORTANCE OF NON-OFFICIAL WORKS ON GEOGRAPHICAL NAMES TO THE UNGEGN ACTIVITIES

- 1- So for the UNGEGN activities are kept within the frame of the geographical names authorities. The question is: why not also give a suitable attention to the non-official studies on geographical names that are done in various parts of the world?
- 2- In Saudi Arabia. as an example, the efforts made by the authorities on geographical names is paralleled by remarkable non-official works. The following is an example of these non-official works:
- 2-1- Mu'jam Al-Bilad Al-Arabiva As-Saudiva which is a comprehensive geographical dictionary covers most of Saudi Arabia. This is written by Hamad Al-Jasir and others.
- 2-2- <u>Mu'jam Ma'ālim Al-Hijāz</u> by Atig Bin Ghaigh Al-Bilādi. This is a place name dictionary on the Hijaz region.
- 2-3-Mu'jam Al-Asmā Al-Jughrafiya Al-Maktūba 'la-Kharā'it Al-Mamlaka Al-Arabiya As-Saudiya Magās 1 : 500,000, by the submitter of this paper. This is an automated gazetteer based on academic research.
- 3- In view of what was mentioned above, it is suggested that :
- a- The UNGEGN encourage reporting by the experts on the nonofficial studies, which may be of importance for the standardization of geographical names, and not limit their reports and papers to the official works only.
- b- The UNGEGN consider honouring one individual in every coming United Nations Conference on the standardization of geographical names for his non-official serious work that provides considerable help to the standardization of geographical names.
