#### Workshop on Toponymy, Frankfurt am Main, 15 September 2003

On the occasion of the visit of a Chinese delegation from the Department of Language Information Administration of the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China to the Federal Agency for Cartography and Geodesy, a workshop on toponymy was organized by the Ständiger Ausschuss für geographische Namen (StAGN). The agenda items discussed comprised questions on the standardisation of geographical names in multilingual areas, in minority languages, in dialectical forms, and according to pronunciation. StAGN members from Austria, Germany and Switzerland participated in the workshop. The programme of the workshop is attached.

As an outcome of the workshop a Memorandum of Understanding of joint activities in the spelling and pronunciation of names in the field of toponymy and anthroponymy was signed between the aforementioned organisations.

The form of cooperation comprises the mutual exchange of lists of most commonly used Chinese and German names and the preparing of respective audio files providing a standardized pronunciation of Chinese and German names.
