Statistics Austria “Gazetteer 2001”

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Publication „GAZETTEER 2001“ of Statistik Austria

Since 1869 the "Gazetteer of Austria" appears each time following the censuses. This publication is not only subdivided according to communes but within each commune into inhabited places (In German an inhabited place is called "Ortschaft" and was originally a place with a name of its own and house numbers running from 1 to n under this name. Now in many cases these house numbers are replaced by named streets with numbers running within each street, but the "Ortschaft" and its name are still an official unity of settlement). Additionally all names of settlements within the inhabited places are cited. A survey of the "Austrian Map 1:50 000" and a map of the commune borders for the respective Federal Province (in German: Bundesland) form the appendix to each of the 9 booklets for the Federal Provinces. A CD-ROM included in each volume contains additionally to the contents of the publication all place names of Austria. Instead of the hitherto printed "Register of the Place Names" for the first time a "Gazetteer of Whole Austria" with all place names is offered – but only as CD-ROM.

Like in former Gazetteers also this time the subdivision into settlements was laid down in cooperation with the communes. Thereby it was endeavoured to achieve the utmost possible congruence between the names material of the Gazetteer and the official map 1:50 000 of the Federal Office of Metrology and Surveying (Bundesamt für Eich- und Vermessungswesen).

The state of the present `Gazetteer is that of May 15th 2001 concerning the administrative Districts (Verwaltungsbezirke) and communes. On the other hand all alterations in the stock of settlements and of the place names were performed until the finish of the editorial work of each Federal Province Booklet.

The publication presents for the administrative units (Federal Provinces, administrative districts, court Districts and communes) as well as for inhabited places (Ortschaften) and census tracts (a subdivision of communes according to the building structure created by Statistik Austria) the number of

- buildings

- _ buildings with main domicile
- _ dwellings (flats)
- _ households
- _ inhabitants (resident population)
- _ further domiciles (in contrast to main domiciles)
- _ local units of employment
- agricultural holdings

The names of the parts of the inhabited places (Ortschaftsbestandteile) used until 1991 are only cited but without data.
