DIVISIONAL REPORT: UNGEGN: ASIA SOUTH-EAST AND PACIFIC SOUTH- WEST DIVISION

Brunei Darussalam hosted the 12th Divisional meeting on 22-24 November 2005. 32 participants from 7 member countries were represented.

The 11th meeting was held in New York and hosted by Permanent Mission of New Zealand to The UN in conjunction with the 22nd Session of The United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names on 23rd April 2002 at New Zealand Mission to The UN.

Two toponymic training courses were held; in 2004 in Bathurst , Australia and 2005 in Malang Indonesia.

Other activities include:

- 1. Compilation of Regional Map and gazetteer coordinated by Australia and New Zealand.
 - A Draft Regional Map was presented during the 12th Divisional meeting by Australia
 - Members agreed to continue gathering information on Generic Terms across the languages of member countries
- 2. Member countries started work on Geographical names database by verifying accuracy of the city data and in identifying any existence of dual names
- 3. There was also work being done on the proposed template for the database on Indigenous and minority Group Names.
