Thailand Report on Geographical Names for the Period 2004 – 2005 for the Twenty-third Session of United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names

1. Standardization of Geographical Names

The work on standardization of Thai geographical names by the National Committee on Geographical Names during the report period including 318 names as approved by the cabinet had been published and distributed.

Another 145 standardized names comprising 112 mountains, 1 passage, 18 water sources, 3 islands and 11 subdistricts had been approved by the committee and submitted to the cabinet for approval.

2. Gazetteers of Thailand

- 2.1 The gazetteer of geographical names of Thailand 1:50,000 scale topographic maps Series L7018 totalling 830 sheets had been completed by the Royal Thai Survey Department.
- 2.2 The work on the Gazetteer of Thailand, Edition 4 including 5 volumes, by the Royal Institute had been completed. The volume one had been published and the volumes 2 5 will be published in 2007.
