The names on this list were formerly approved by the US Board on Geographic Names as conventional names for optional use. In the course of the review leading to publication of the Conventional Names Gazetteer in March 1972, these names were judged no longer required. Not included are names of former entities permissible for use in historical context only (e.g. Armorica) and still valid names of entities whose labels were changed from "conventional" to "English", or to "long form" and "short form" (e.g. Cameroon, Ireland, and Gambia).
