## INFERNATIONAL GAZEFTEERS

Submitted by Hungary

The January 1975 meeting of the East Central and South East Europe -Soviet Union Divisions at Budapest discussed the question of international gazetteers. The meeting agreed that the suggestion put forward in Anner VI, Report of the Group of Experts on Geographical Names at its fifth session (p. 35) regarding a series of United Nations Gazetteers of the world, especially the details given in point <sup>8</sup>, paragraph (a), are not acceptable for the countries of the two divisions.

The meeting, on the other hand, suggested that a series of national gazet(ears should be published in a uniform solution, by the countries themselves, under the auspices of the United Nations.

The title page and the necessary information should be in the official language(s) of the respective country, end in one or more official languages of the UN. The title page should contain, among others, the following details (blank spaces should be filled in by the respective country names):
