LIST OF COUNTRY NAMES

Submitted by Hungary

As the member of the Working Group for the List of Country Names, the representative of Hungary asked countries of his Division, as well as those of the East Asia Division to submit the name of their country in the official language and in the six official languages of the United Nations.

As a result, the names of six countries (Bulgaria, China, Hungary, Poland, Romania and Yugoslavia) have been received and sent to the Chairman of the Working Group. No answer has been received from Albania, Czechoslovakia, Japan, Mongolia, People's Democratic Republic of Korea, or South Korea. Questionnaires have been sent recently to these countries for the second time.

It is worthwhile mentioning that some names given as an answer to the questionnaires evidently need correction on behalf of the users of the six UN languages. Therefore, we suggest a review of these and other names and we will send them to the respective national organs for approval.
