Changes in the Official Romanization System for Hebrew

Summary***

After 50 years of use, the official romanization system of Hebrew has now been somewhat amended. The paper points out the reasons for the changes and lists the five main divergences from the "old" system, which were ratified in November 2006. They are now in the early stages of implementation. A government directive states that their application in all official road signs and maps should be completed within five years.
