## Summary\*\*\*

The present report details the development of the Kaurna place names website. The development of the site has been an initiative of the agreement between the Kaurna people of the Adelaide region of South Australia and four local government authorities in the southern portion of metropolitan Adelaide and the adjacent rural areas.

The report outlines the reason for, and the scope of, the website and explains the development process, the end result and the expectations connected with the website.
