Turkey

Current GDP estimate series are based on year 1987 and are compliant with 1968 SNA. Turkish Statistical Institute is in the process of upgrading the system of national accounts from 1968 SNA to 1993 SNA by the base year 1998

Since Turkish Statistical Institute is in process upgrading from 1968 SNA to 1993 SNA there is no priority about revision within 1993 SNA. Estimation of total value added of multinational and multiregional companies may have priority.

There is no dedicated survey in order to integrate informal sector to system of national accounts. In order to incorporate unobserved economy to system of national accounts, household labor survey results are used.
