The meeting will be held on 25-26 February 2015. Morning sessions will start at 9:30 A.M. Afternoon sessions will start at 2:00 P.M. Afternoon sessions will close at 6:00 P.M.

***Confirmed country expert participants:*** your country's Mission to the United Nations may be able to assist you in getting the UN grounds pass (<http://www.un.org/en/members/>). **If your mission cannot assist, please inform Mr. Zin Lin at [lin@un.org](mailto:lin@un.org) by 17 February.** You will be met at the lobby of the UN DC2 building (2 UN Plaza on East 44th Street between 1st and 2nd Avenue) by one of our staff members from 8:30 A.M. to 9:30 A.M. on the first morning of the meeting (25 January) where you will be given a temporary United Nations grounds pass to proceed to the meeting room at the main UN building.

Alternatively, you can pick up your pass the day before the event with Mr. **Zin Lin** (see contact information on the next page). If you are arriving later than 9:30 A.M. on 25 February, please notify Mr. Zin Lin to make other arrangements to pick up your grounds pass.

A grounds pass is required at all times to enter all United Nations buildings. **There will not be “extra” ground passes, so please be sure to inform us if you will be joined by any other members of your delegation who require a temporary UN grounds pass. Send us their name, title and organization to Mr. Zin Lin at [lin@un.org](mailto:lin@un.org) by 17 February.**

***Attendants from UN agencies, funds and programmes:*** please request your New York Office to have a UN Ground Pass issued for you in advance of the meeting. UNSD will not be responsible for grounds passes for participants from UN agencies, funds and programmes.

***Attendants from non-governmental organizations (NGOs):*** Please note that while invitations have been sent to a limited number of experts from National Statistics Systems, UN Agencies and International Organizations, representatives of NGOs are certainly welcome to attend both the EGM and the Friday Seminar as observers, as long as they are already in possession of a UN grounds pass to enter UN premises (e.g., representatives of NGOs accredited with the Economic and Social Council or with the Department of Public Information).

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Immigration Requirements

Participants should contact relevant United States of America embassies or consulates on visa requirements, and obtain the appropriate entry permit where necessary as early as possible.

The official notification letter is generally sufficient to be used as supporting documentation for visa (entry permit) request. Please contact us, should there be any issues with obtaining visa for the purpose of attending this event.

### Money

The majority of ATMs (Automated Teller Machines) networks in New York City are linked to a network that most likely includes your bank at home. Hence, you would be able to make a cash withdrawal if you have a cash card (ATM Card) that offers **Cirrus** (<http://www.mastercard.com/atmlocator/index.jsp>) or **Plus** ([www.visa.com/atm](http://www.visa.com/atm)), the 2 most popular networks. There are fees and daily limits associated with withdrawing money using the above networks. Please check with your bank at home for this information.

Traveller's cheques are another good and safe alternative. Be sure to keep a record of their serial numbers, so you are ensured a refund in case they are lost or stolen. The 3 most popular traveller's cheque providers are **American Express** (American Express branches, [www.americanexpress.com](http://www.americanexpress.com)), **Visa** (Citibank branches), **MasterCard** (Thomas Cook Currency Services).

Credit Cards are a convenient way to pay for transactions. **American Express, Visa and MasterCard** (among others) are accepted virtually everywhere in New York.

## LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

**Subway and buses** (<http://www.mta.info/>) are a convenient way to get around Manhattan. **Metro Card** valid for subway and bus can be purchased at subway stations.

- Single: trip fare is \$2.50.
- 7-Day Metro Card costs \$30.00 (unlimited ride for one week for one person)

**Yellow Cab Taxis** are readily available around Manhattan. Taxis are a safe alternative for late night travel when train and buses can be few and far between. It is advisable not to take taxis without meters (illegal taxi), as they could charge exorbitant fares. Taxi fees can be paid in cash or credit card, however, if paying in cash, it is a good idea to have small bills because taxi drivers usually cannot change anything higher than \$20. While taxis are relatively expensive for a single person, they are more affordable with 3 or more riders. The rates for taxis are as follows:

Initial fare.....	\$2.50
Each 1/5 mile (4 blocks)....	\$0.50
Each 1 minute idle.....	\$0.40
Night surcharge.....	\$0.50 (after 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.)
Additional riders.....	FREE

Pay only what's on the meter, plus a 15-20 per cent gratuity. On all trips within New York City, any bridge and tunnel tolls to the destination shall be paid by the passenger, who shall be so informed before the start of the trip. On all trips within the City of New York, return tolls shall not be charged except for trips over the Cross Bay Veterans, Marine Parkway-Gil Hodges Memorial, and Verrazano Narrows Bridges. On trips beyond the City of New York, all necessary tolls to and from the destination shall be paid by the passenger. There are additional charges for crossings outside the metropolitan area and New Jersey. Passengers are required to pay one way.
