Goal 8: Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all

Target 8.5: By 2030, achieve full and productive employment and decent work for all women and men, including young people and persons with disabilities, and equal pay for work of equal value

Framework: Decent work (1999) through 4 strategic objectives: job creation, rights at work, social protection and social dialogue; In 2005, the World Sunmmit of the UNGA resolved to include full and productive employment and DW in the MDGs; July 2006: ECOSOC Ministerial Declaration recognised DW agenda as a key instrument to achieve the objective. Presidential summits in all regions, including EC communication.

Indicators:

- 8.5.1 Employment to working-age population by gender and age group and people with disabilities
- 8.5.2 Unemployment rate by gender and age group
- 8.5.3 Working poverty rate measured at 2 PPP per capita/day by gender
- 8.5.4 Combined rate of UE and potential LF (LU3)
- 8.5.5 Share of informal employment in total employment by gender
- 8.5.6 Share of wage employment with incomes (wages) above the threshold in non-agriculture employment by gender
- 8.5.7 Gender wage gap
- 8.5.8 Time related underutilization by gender and age group













Combined rate of unemployment and potential labour force (LU3):

(Persons in unemployment + potential labour force) / extended labour force, by gender


