

Chapter 22 : The General Government and Public Sectors

1.	General comment	As known, this chapter was not included in the SNA 1993 but most of the elaboration is already in practice. With the dedication of government sector, it gives special focus and guidelines for compiling the general government and public sectors.
2.	Sub-sectors of the general government sector	As described in chapter 4 and also in paragraph 22.43, sub-sector of general government can be divided into 3 levels which are central, state and local plus NPIs and social security fund. In the case of Malaysia and might be in some other countries, the statutory bodies of the financial nature have been considered as financial corporation in the existing practice and another level of non-financial statutory bodies as federal government. Is NPIs mentioned in this revision suggesting that the financial statutory body to be reclassified as NPIs which is a new emerging phenomenon that needs special focus.
