Annex

ACC programme classification: statistics part

The statistics part of the ACC programme classification is multipurpose, aiming at facilitating: (a) the coordination of collection and dissemination of data by the international agencies members of the ACC Subcommittee on Statistical Activities; (b) the presentation of integrated work programmes in statistics of the international agencies; (c) the combined analysis of resources deployed in different fields of statistics by the agencies; and (d) the coordination of the statistical activities of the agencies, in particular international statistical training and technical cooperation.

The highest level of the classification, dividing general statistics into four broad categories, is the basic element used for ACC programme classification, and shall not be modified without the approval of ACC. The lower levels of the classification may be revised, as required, by the ACC Subcommittee on Statistical Activities.

The following classification has been adopted by the ACC Subcommittee on Statistical Activities at its thirty-third session, held in Madrid from 14 to 16 September 1999.

The entry in parentheses after each item at the lowest level of classification refers to the corresponding element in the classification adopted by the Conference of European Statisticians for use in the integrated presentation of statistical programmes of the Economic Commission for Europe, the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development and the Statistical Office of the European Communities.
