

ABSTRACT

The presentation will describe the initiatives by Eurostat and the European Statistical System on the request for qualified statisticians, fulfilling on one side the new requests for modern IT and Enterprise Architecture oriented staff, on the other side for staff with high expertise in the most important domains of official European Statistics that are also capable of communicating statistics. Eurostat's Young Professional Statisticians Induction and Learning Program (Y PSILON) will be discussed as well as the initiative for the European Master in Official Statistics (EMOS), in which the European Statistical System is setting up a comprehensive cooperation with a large number of European Universities. The presentation will also highlight the training methods and tools as well as how Eurostat includes these in its cooperation with third countries and regions outside the EU. An enhanced cooperation between organisations involved in training in statistics all over the world is proposed as a way to enhance the efforts and effectiveness of training also by using and exchanging experiences in modern ways of learning and training.
