CUSTOMS DECLARATIONS- REVISED KYOTO CONVENTION, SINGLE ADMINISTRATIVE DOCUMENT AND RELATION TO IMTS (BOTSWANA)

Single Administrative Document (SAD)

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- A single document for administering all customs transactions
- Replaced various forms used previously
- Introduced by Botswana Customs and Excise in May 2002.
- SAD brought both direct and indirect advantages

Direct Advantages

- Reduction of various documents previously used for declaring goods
- Single document easy to understand over time
- Uses international country codes & Customs procedure Codes, insuring international comparability of data







Trading partners

• With re-exports customs captures country of origin (if available), the exporting country and the importing country.

Change of Country of origin

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 With regard to goods for inward processing, where the value added during processing is at least 25% of the original value of the commodity being exported after processing, origin changes to the exporting country If country of origin changes because the commodity has changed and is now being declared under a different customs procedure, e.g. being exported after processing, a new customs declaration is made.

 If only a correction is made on the original declaration; i.e. country of origin was not correct, then a voucher of correction is made in respect of the original declaration

4.11	7100	Direct entry for customs warehouse procedure
4.12	7171;4071; 1071	Goods moving from a warehouse into another warehouse; goods cleared for home consumption from a warehouse; goods permanently exported after warehousing.
4.18	8000	Goods on Transit



8.03- Though recommendation is that country of origin be used as partner, in the case of re-exports this is not always the case

8.07- Requested preferential treatment not taken into account in compilation of IMTS, but the information is available in the declaration forms.

8.10 & 8.11 Country of consignment & sale available in the declaration but the compilation of IMTS considers exporting country only.
