## **Balance of Payments Revised Draft Classification of Services**

## Note by OECD Statistics Directorate

The following table represents the current state of progress, at least from the perception of OECD, regarding the proposed Balance of Payments Classification of Services following the BOPCOM October 2004, and the AEG and BOPTEG December 2004. There appear to be a number of outstanding issues:

i) Is "goods for processing" to be categorised as trade in goods or a trade in services?

ii) Should "post and courier" be re-classified as the last category of Transport. Should this main category "transport" be renamed?

iii) Information Technology Services (Is this an appropriate name for this grouping including telecommunications, computer and information services?)

iv) Should "Insurance" be split in BOPS into "direct insurance" and "reinsurance"?

v) Franchise fees and payments for the use of similar rights? (There is a question of name and coverage ? Will software license fees for reproduction be included and if not where will they go?)

vi) There is a general question of the classification of trade in digital products, and originals?

vii) Will merchanting go to trade in goods? If so what will 10.1 become?

These issues are indicated by a question mark in the table, which is developed from that shown in BOPTEG Issue Paper 17. Are there any other issues that should be discussed regarding the BOPS?
