Summary**

The report summarizes the follow-up actions taken by States Members of the United Nations and by the secretariat, working groups and divisions of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names on the resolutions adopted at the Tenth United Nations Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names, held in New York from 31 July to 9 August 2012.

The format used in reporting on the implementation of resolutions was adopted at the Seventh Conference held in 1998, and used at the Eighth Conference and thereafter for monitoring the status of actions taken on previous Conference resolutions.
