Administrative structure of national names authorities**

Document submitted by Cuba

Summary

The document contains a brief explanation of the composition of the national body of the Republic of Cuba responsible for the standardization of geographical names.

It explains that the National Committee is a permanent body which reports to the Council of Ministers and is presided over by the Instituto Cubano de Geodesía y Cartografía (Cuban Institute of Geodesy and Cartography) and that, in addition to the National Committee, there are permanent working groups and ad-hoc Working Groups are set up as necessary.

The document points out further, that the work of the National Committee is co-ordinated with the activities of the specialized technical groups of the provinces and the work of the latter with the activities of municipalities.
