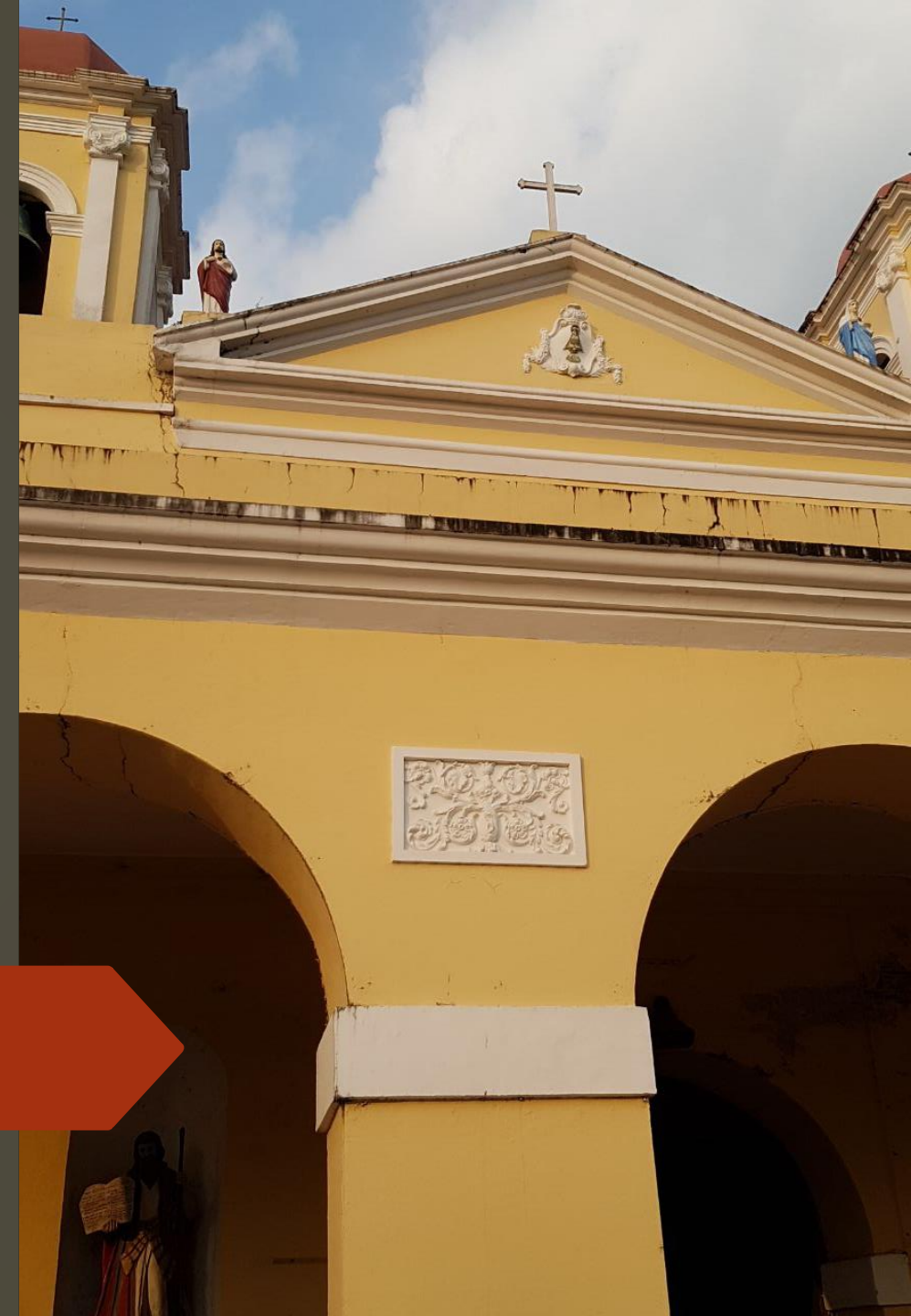

# Our Lady of Caysasay Shrine

- ▶ Name used by local government: **Our Lady of Caysasay Shrine**
- ▶ Pronunciation: **Cay-sa-say**
- ▶ Original Language: **Tagalog**
- ▶ Meaning: this name came from King fisher bird called “Kasay-kasay” in Tagalog
- ▶ Language of origin: **Tagalog named by Spanish**
- ▶ Meaning: It was named after the birds “**Kasay-kasay**” were the foretold apparition of Our Lady of Casaysa was seen
- ▶ Historical name: **Cay-sa-say**
- ▶ Remarks: This church will be reached by passing thru San Lorenzo Ruiz Steps (125 steps) and the sacred Well of Sta Lucia.
