Global Consultation on the Strategy for Implementing the 2025 SNA and BPM 7 $\, \&$

The updates of the System of National Accounts and the Balance of Payments and International Investment Position Manual have taken place in a highly-coordinated manner, and updated versions of both Manuals are expected to be approved in early 2025. Reflecting the coordination of the updates, as well as a general desire to see maximum harmonization across macro-economic statistics, implementation of the updated standards will also be handled in a coordinated manner.

This document sets out the overarching strategy for implementation of the SNA2025 and *BPM7*. It builds on earlier versions of the strategy that have been discussed with key stakeholders and by the AEG and BOPCOM. It is now being presented for global consultation. The strategy will be finalised by the end of January 2025, for submission to the 56th Session of the United Nations Statistical Commission for its endorsement at the time the Commission approves the 2025 SNA. It is also expected to be endorsed by the IME's Chief Statistician in association with his responsibility for approving
