

The PSAC seeks to convene top public and private sector leaders to determine how the private sector can play a greater role in UAE SDG progress



Based on survey and interview insights, we developed a framework for strengthening public-private data-sharing partnerships for SDG achievement

- 1. Collaborate to create a voluntary policy for data sharing that reflects both parties' sustainable development priorities
- 2. Leverage collective perspectives on sustainability taxonomy to build a standardized model for data sharing
- 3. Identify entities for partnership to implement the data-sharing model
- 4. Implement a secure, data exchange layer and a digital statistics system
- 5. Increase the publicity of SDG developments in English media outlets










UAE is ranked 5th globally in OECD's Official Development Assistance
