












BASQUE COMMITMENT MODEL FOR THE LOCALIZATION OF THE SDGS

A model to develop the concept of localization through a **commitment at three levels**, as it addresses institutions, different social actors and the general public.


An approach which allows us to contribute to the global Sustainable Development Goals while addressing local realities.


