



Membership (User Profile)

While the Hub will be open to any visitor, the levels of engagement are designed to have four levels of access:

- Visitor: general public to an open website
 - => Page with an overview of the hub and access to some public information;
- <u>Member</u>: users need to register and provide some relevant information including interests and skills
 - => Access to members-only information; ability to generate and join projects and load information
- Administrator: superusers that moderate the flow of information in the hub, approve documentation upload and projects
- Owner: users in charge of the site management and privileges across administrators
