◆ Resources

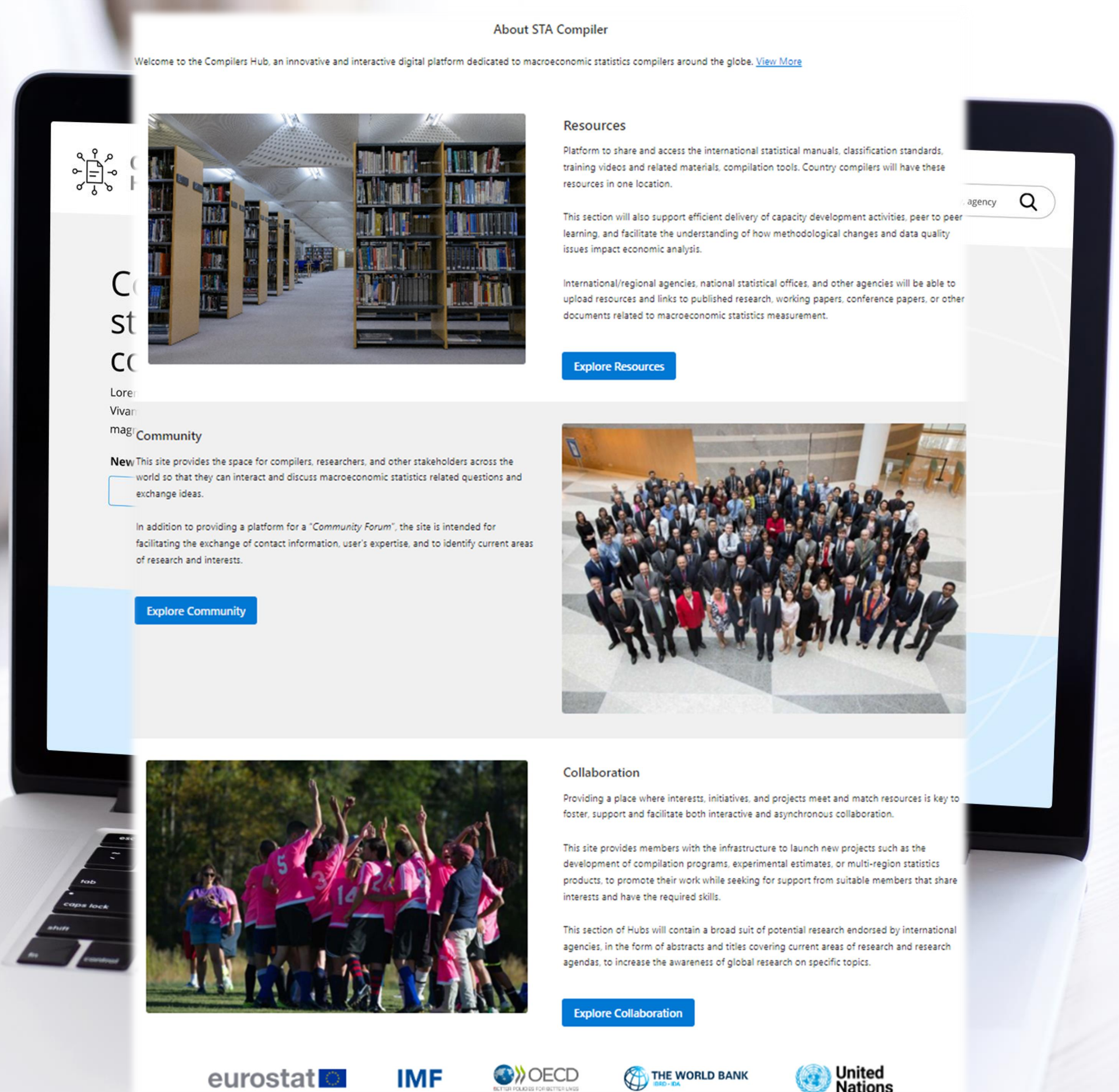
- *Digital Library; Research Corner;*

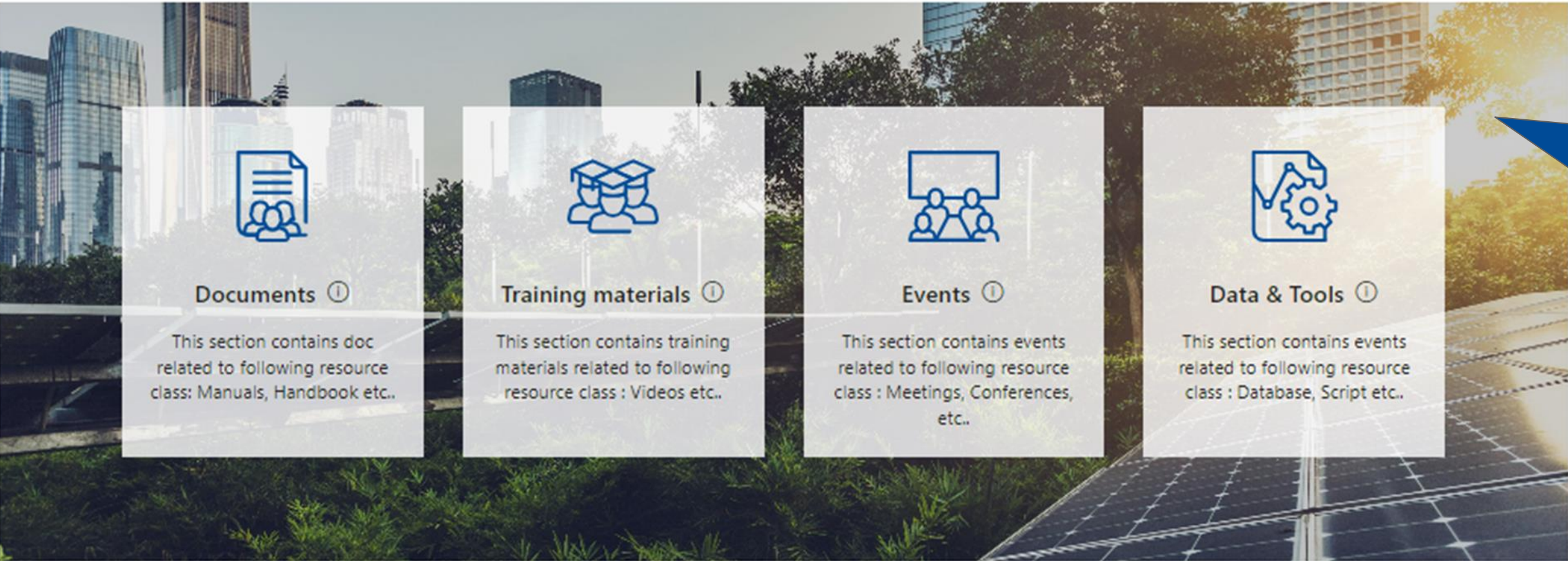
Allows for easy access to:

Content featured based on the user's profile – (domains, topics and other interests)

Membership (User Profile)

While the Hub will be open to any visitor, the levels of engagement are designed to have four levels of access:

- Visitor: general public to an open website
=> Page with an overview of the hub and access to some public information;
- Member: users need to register and provide some relevant information including interests and skills
=> Access to members-only information; ability to generate and join projects and load information
- Administrator: superusers that moderate the flow of information in the hub, approve documentation upload and projects
- Owner: users in charge of the site management and privileges across administrators

‘Talk2manuals’ Bot:



=> All manuals combined, are several thousands of pages

=> Difficult to read and extract information

The Bot (ChatGPT-type) will be integrated in the Hub and will:

- Make interaction user friendly
- Leverage new AI technologies
- Make the solution a public good
- Be rail guarded by the “Resources” within the Hub
