### **Background**


 The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) is the primary statistical arm of the government. It is responsible in the conduct and content of all national censuses and surveys, gathering of sectoral statistics, consolidation of selected administrative recording systems, and compilation of national accounts.

### Background

 The PSA is responsible in planning, developing, prescribing, disseminating, and enforcing policies, rules and regulations, and coordinating government—wide programs on the production of official general purpose statistics and civil registration services.

### **Background**

 Being the central statistical authority of the Philippine government on primary data collection, the PSA is tasked to collect, compile, analyze, abstract, and publish statistical information relating to country's economic, social, demographic, political, and general welfare of the people.

- For official statistics, the PSA has to issue Press Release through its PSA website for the advance information to its users.
- ➤ All information on the website are simultaneously feed to our PSA Facebook and Twitter account for wider dissemination.

- ➤ PSA also receives data request from Electronic Freedom of Information Portal (eFOI)
- ➤ PSA submits quarterly report to Presidential Communications Operations Office (PCOO)

#### Data Enclave

➤ Under circumstances where a researcher is in dire need of data that are considered to be non-sharable, PSA has Data Enclave wherein a researcher can do his analysis using the data available.

- Focus on **macro** level data and metadata


Online Databases (Current setup)

- Developed with the assistance of consultants from World Bank
- •Inventory of Statistical Standards in the Philippines
  - Aims to harmonize the **standards** in the Philippine Statistical System (PSS)
  - > Features:
    - Official Concepts and Definitions for Statistical Purposes;
    - Methodologies and Procedures; and
    - Classification Systems of the PSS

- ➤ A PSA's platform committed to making government more OPEN, ACCOUNTABLE, and RESPONSIVE to citizens.




- It was called open data because...

  - not restricted for use
  - free of copyrights, and
  - available for the public.


- > PSA Open Data aspires to
  - Contribute towards achievement of Sustainable Development Goals
  - Facilitate an inclusive, sustainable and resilient development
  - Promote a National Data Sharing and Accountability Policy
  - Promote usage of Open Appreciation Programme Interfaces
  - Increase and improve the utilization of data for decision-making,
    citizen improvement, innovation and entrepreneurship support
  - Support capacity building and innovation for the generation,
    sharing and utilization of data at national, regional, and local level

- > Features of the Enhanced OpenSTAT
  - Dynamic generation of tables where users are able to interactively query the data and do transposition of variables (or pivoting) easily to generate the desired table formats.
  - Quick generation of commonly used statistical charts to support data analysis.
  - Easier generation of thematic maps
  - Quick conversion to several file formats such as Excel, CSV, JSON, XML, HTML, and others

- PSA Information Center (Library)
  - ➤ PSA maintains and organizes more than 10,000 volumes of printed and e-copy of reference materials



- Radio Program
  - ➤ PSA also take advantage its exposure to media through its PSA Radio Program which is simultaneously aired live via PSA Facebook account.



- Forums, PressCon
  - The PSA recognizes the important role of media in promoting and popularizing official statistical information.



- For this reason, the PSA always have its reservation in conducting press conferences and media fora.
- ➤ Primary objective is to preserve the relevance and integrity of data before its release to public.

#### Publications

Along with its dissemination tools guided by a technology, PSA still continues to compile and produce publications such as Philippine Statistical Yearbook, Philippines in Figures, Quarterly Philippine Statistics in Brief, and Monthly Statistics Indicators and many more.
