Project goals



Effective monitoring of the SDGs and improved evidence-based policy making

- Improved **capacity** of project countries to support SDG monitoring
- Increased **availability** of SDG Indicators at National and International levels
- Improved **coordination** of NSS around SDG indicators



Increased **awareness and usage** of the indicators in the society



User engagement

Collecting data and metadata to monitor progress on the SDGs is of little value if it is not used.

- Need to **identify users and address their needs** a major feature of the project, both for the national and global platforms

User engagement strategies are expected to be developed by countries if these are not already in place.



User engagement – two way engagement



Key aspect is to learn from users what they want – understand what makes them interested in our statistics.

Can adjust and develop new products based on this.



Will cover various elements of user engagement

- Different user groups
 - Means of engagement with users on their needs
 - Tools and methods for reaching users
- User engagement strategies and implementation plans to continuously engage with users

User engagement strategies



- Complement NSDS (or other relevant plans)
 - Rooted in the national statistical legislation
 - Action focused
 - Responsive to changing demands
 - Country owned
 - Developed through a consultative process
