Is the graphical representation of information and data.

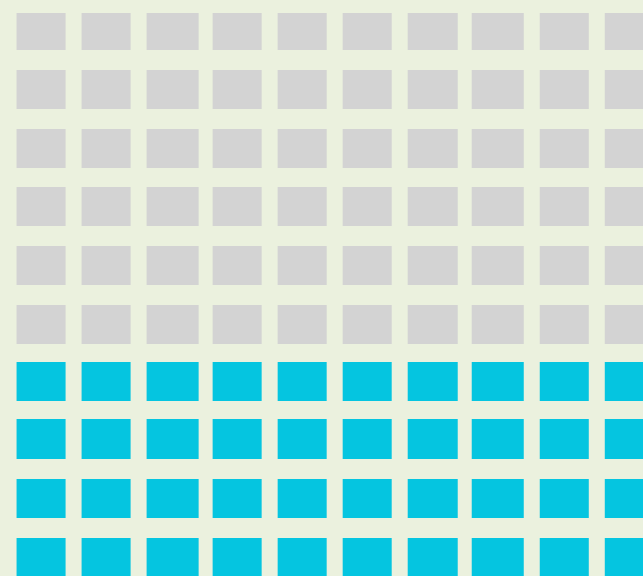
Visually, visually communicate data in many different ways, such as a line graph, bar chart, pie chart, scatter plot, or map.

It makes the data more natural for the human mind to comprehend and therefore makes it easier to identify trends, patterns, and outliers within large data sets.

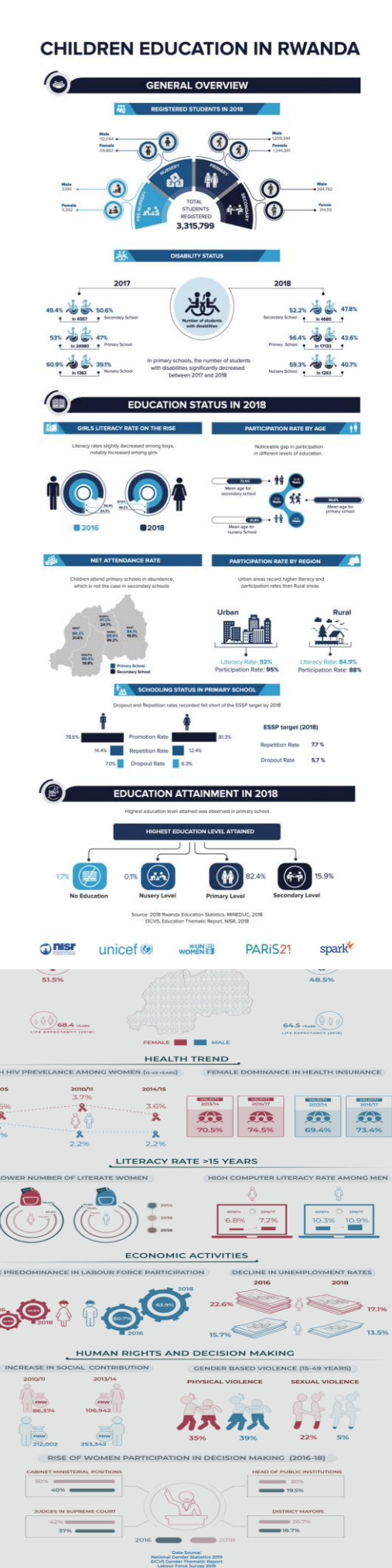
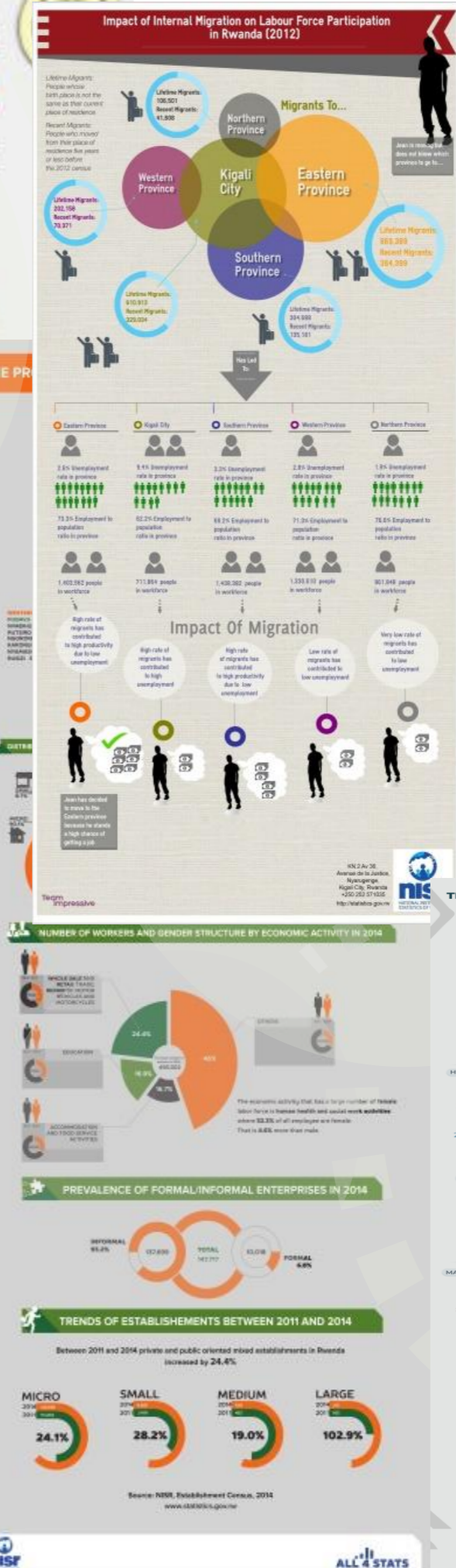
We know that good data leads to better decisions. But there's a step between analyzing high quality data and making an informed decision that is sometimes neglected
