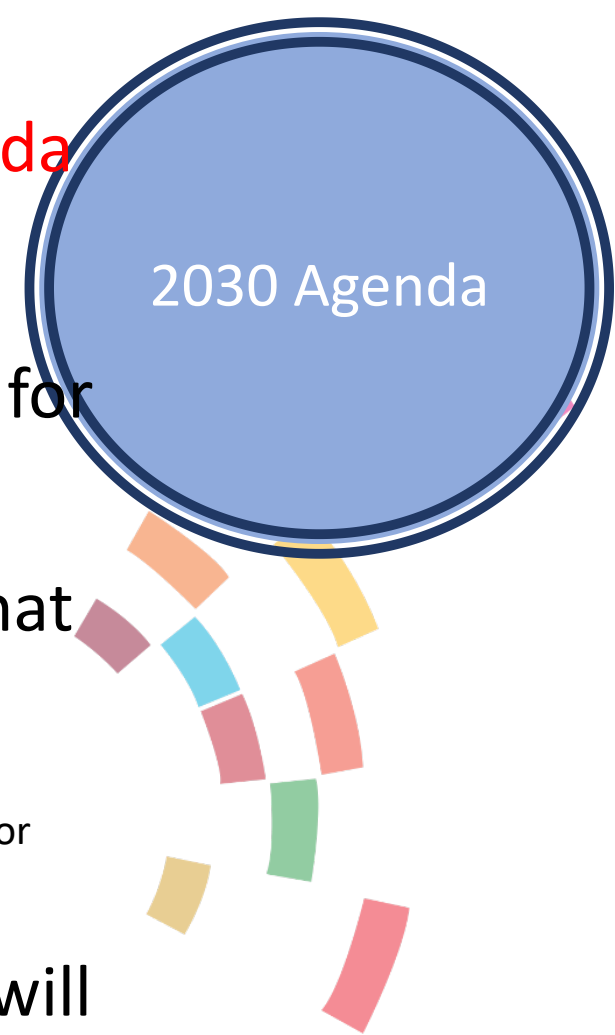


Strengthening National Statistical Systems for the 2030 Agenda

National official data sources and data produced by national statistical systems (NSS) are at the heart of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The 2030 Agenda is guided by a set of principles, including that

- “the global review will be primarily based on national official data sources.” *A/RES/70/1, Transforming Our World: the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, paragraph 74 (a)*
- “follow-up and review at the high-level political forum will be informed by an annual progress report on the Sustainable Development Goals ... based on the global indicator framework and data produced by NSS and information collected at the regional level.” *(Ibid, paragraph 83)*

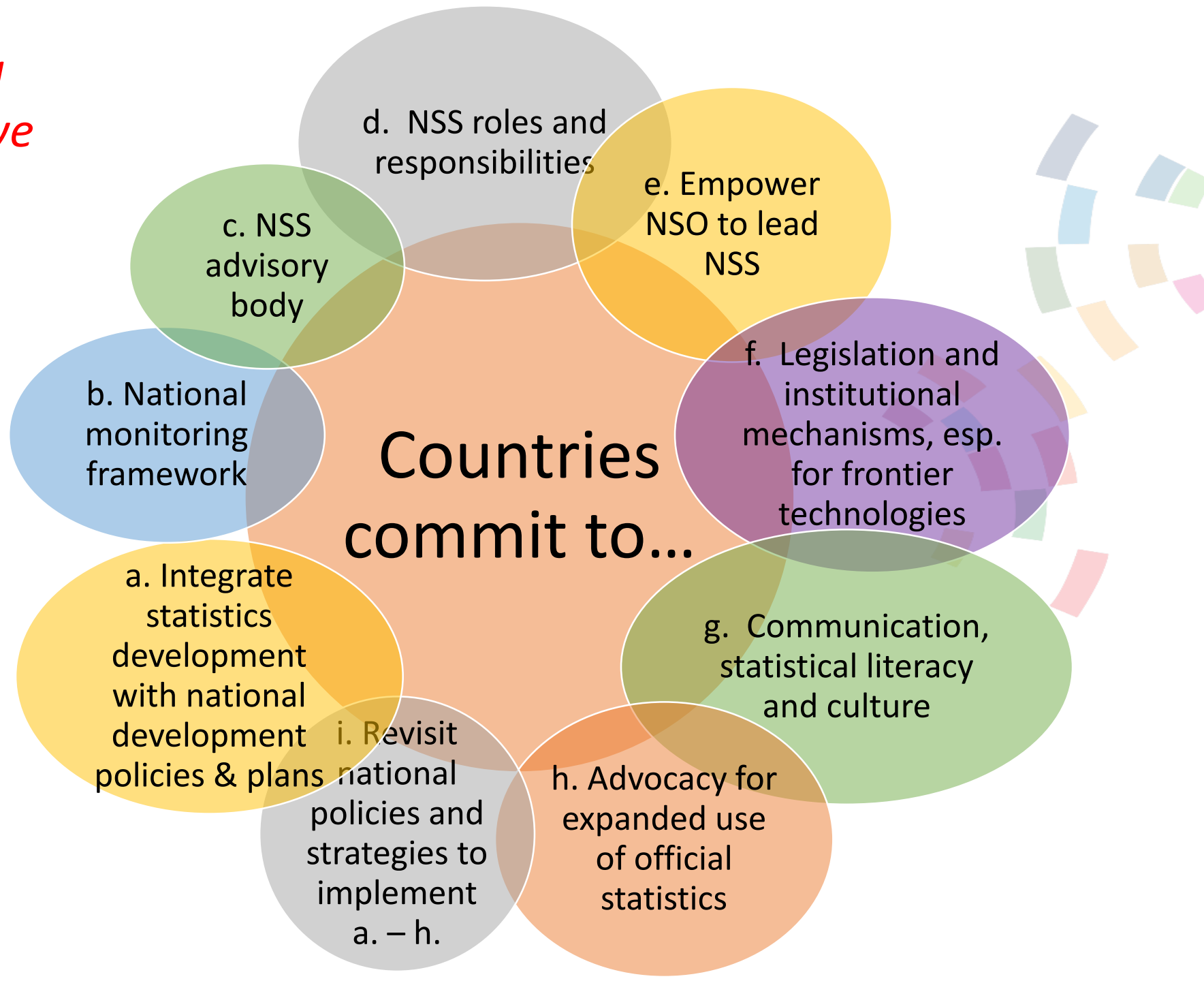

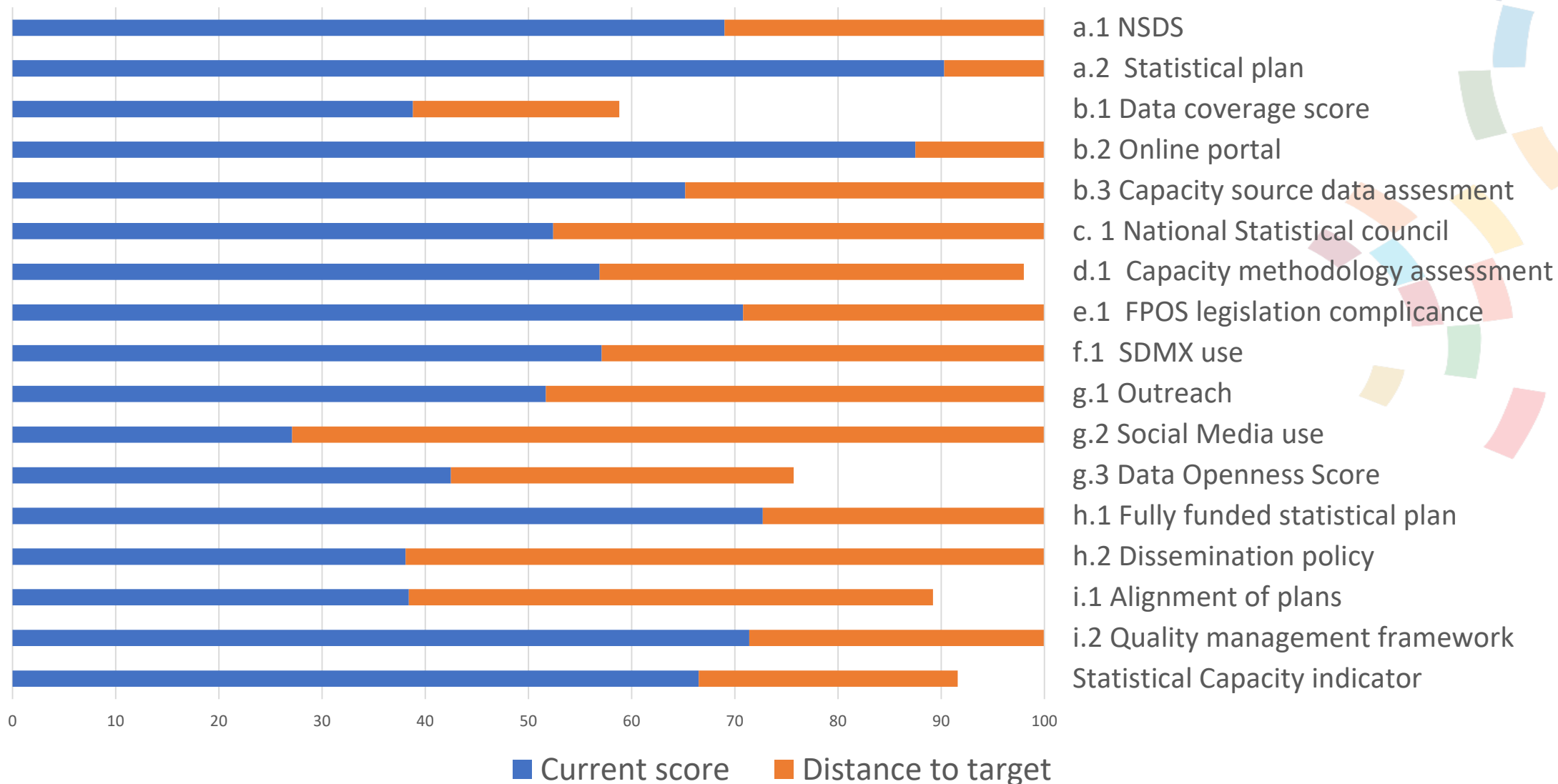

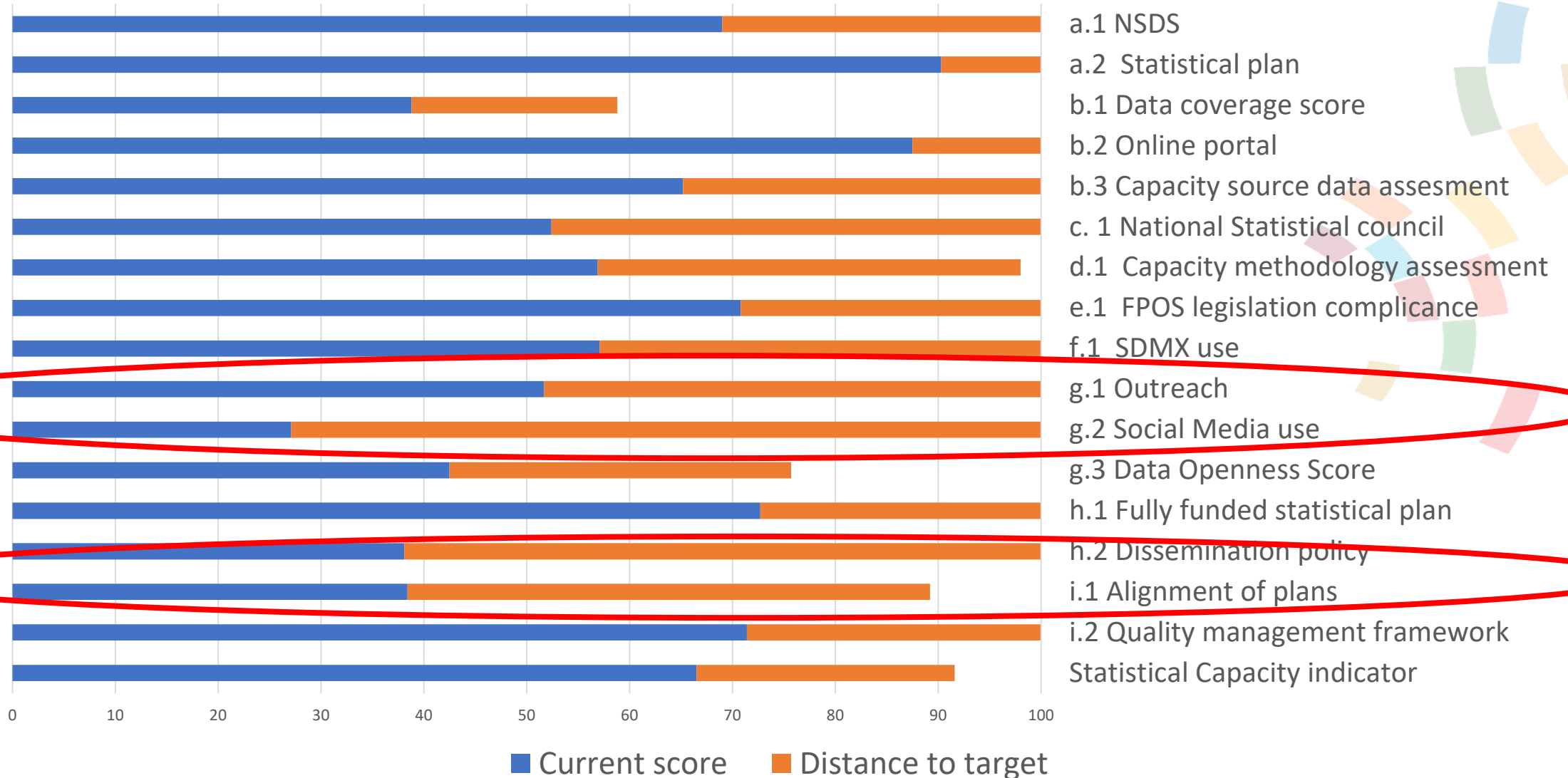

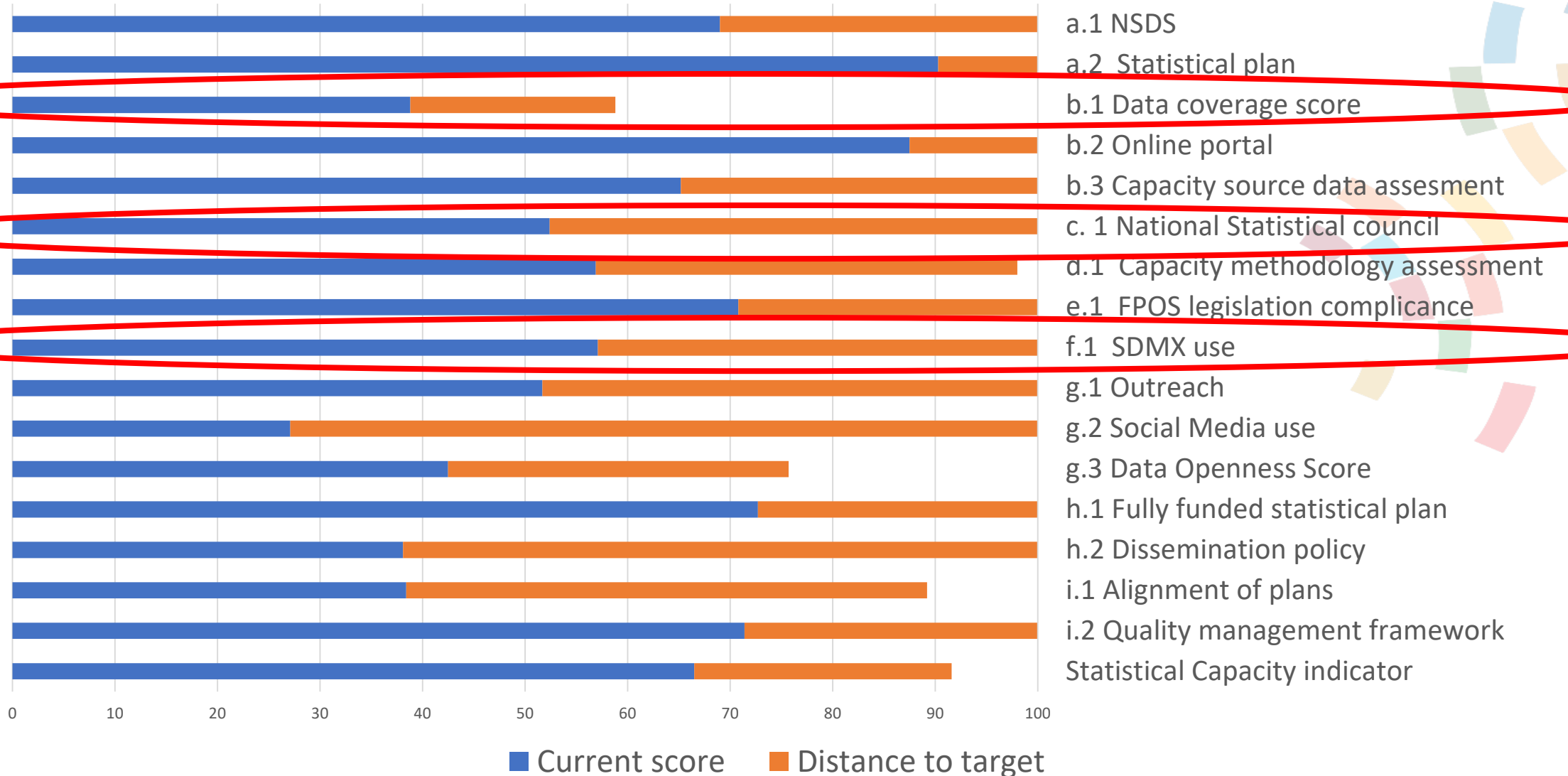

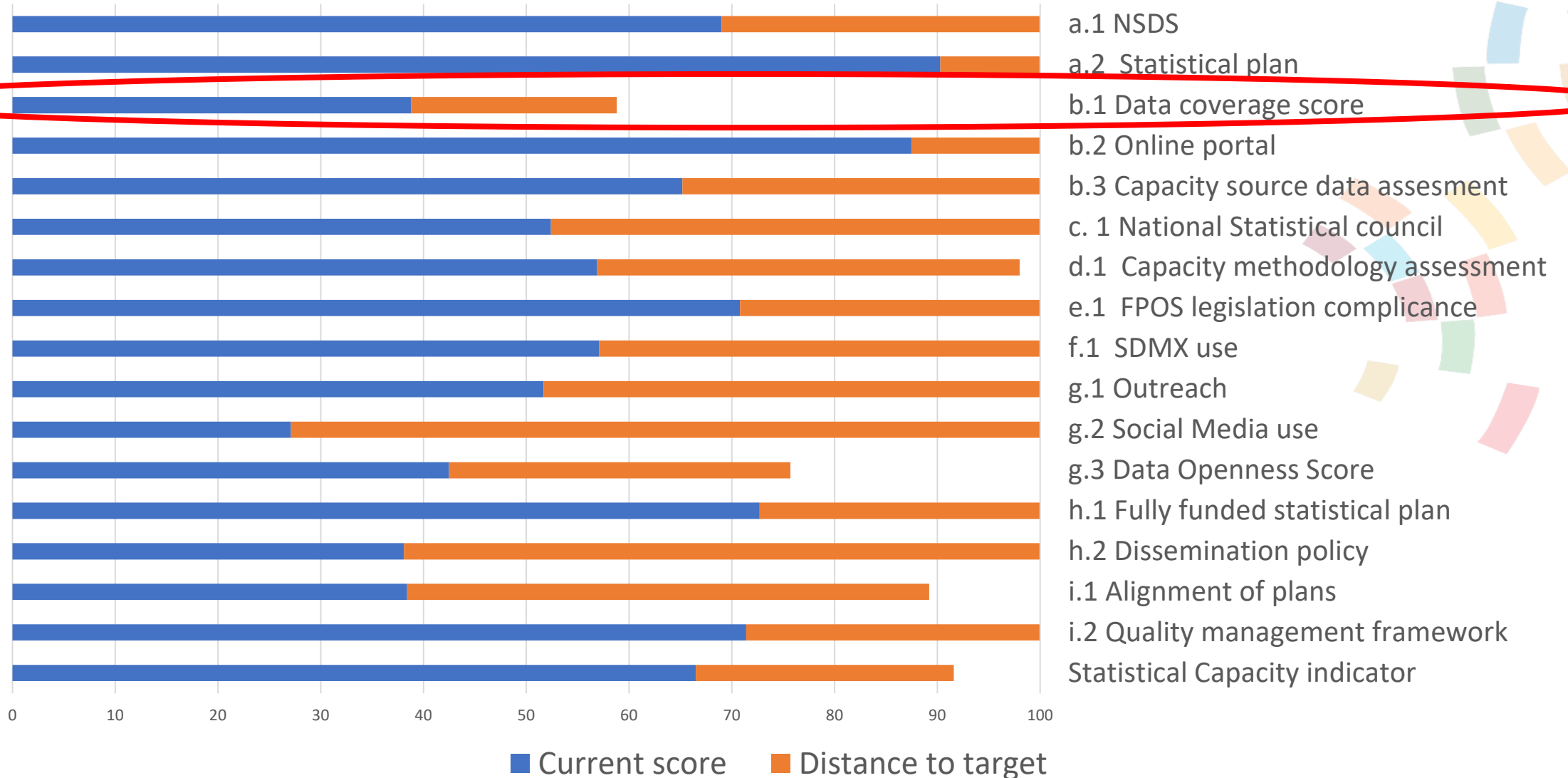

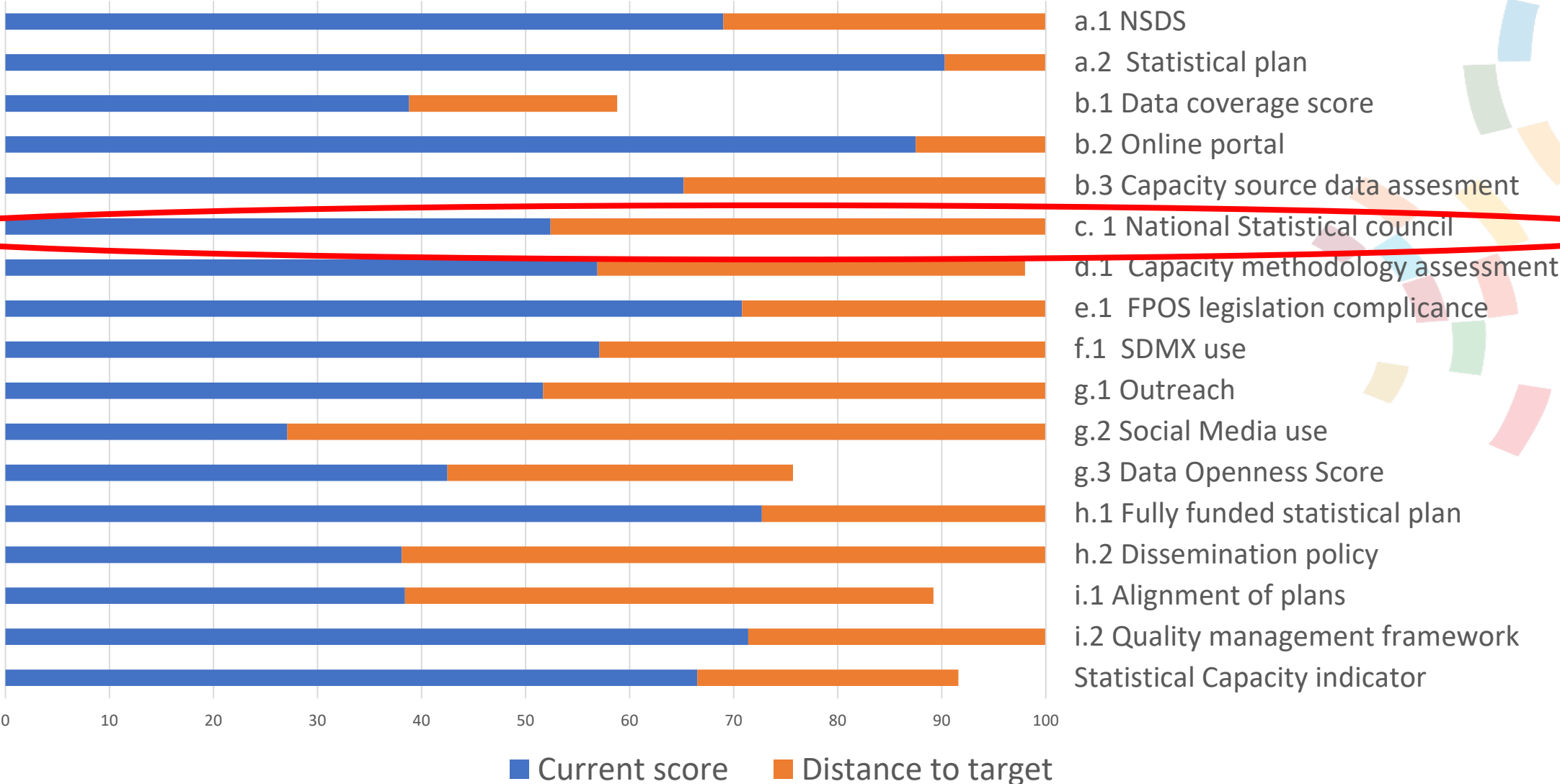

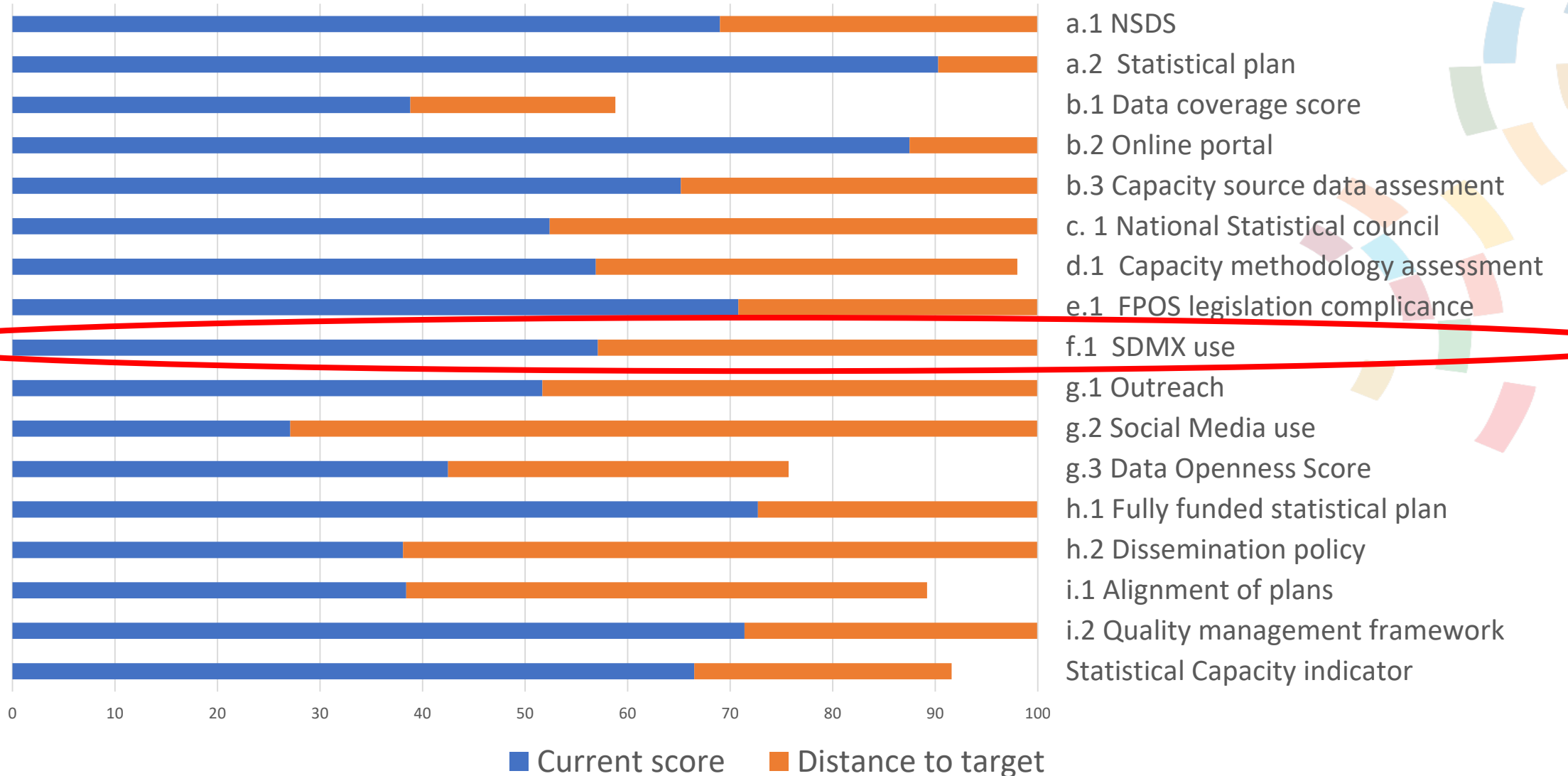

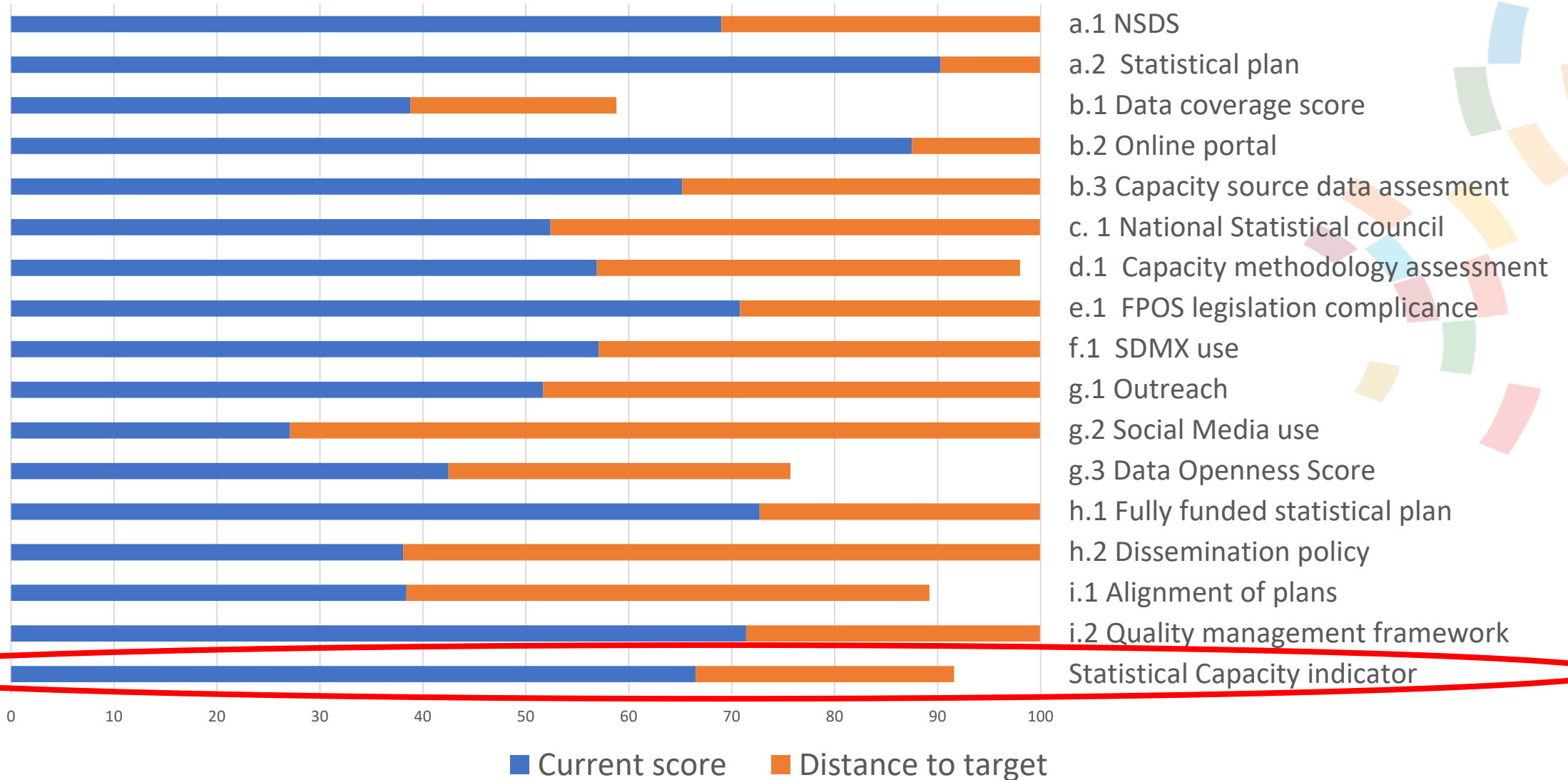
