Challenges in producing statistics to meet the needs of users

- 1. Staff
 - a. Number of staff
 - b. Staff capacity
 - c. Staff turnover
- 2. Support from government
 - a. Finance
 - b. Expanding the division
- 3. Quality and completeness of collected data
- 4. Coordinating collection activities
- 5. Stakeholders engagement

Strategies adopted to address some of these challenges

- 1. Reproducible Analytical Pipeline (R Studio) Mentorship
 - a. Started with import and export
 - b. Apply what we learn to other areas arrival and departure
- 2. Two-hour knowledge sharing sessions once a week
 - a. Share what we learn from workshops/conferences/mentorships
- 3. Data dissemination using dashboards on website
 - a. Increase visibility for CSD
- 4. Statistical Population Register
 - a. Enable integration of administrative, census, and survey data
 - b. Resident enumerators
- 5. Data dissemination workshops
