Update on GLOS and Guidance

- GLOS and CES Guidance on Modernizing Statistical Legislation have been useful in updating, revising or developing a national statistical legislation in countries.
- There is no need to completely rewrite the generic law: add or expand certain elements
- Merge GLOS explanatory notes and Guidance: what is needed in addition e.g. social license, cooperation and partnership with other stakeholders.
- More on communication to different personas: how to explain the need and relevance of the legal provisions to the general public, parliament, other stakeholders
- National constitutional setting differs → adapt
- World is changing and role of NSO is changing a regular review schedule could be agreed.



Missing/Insufficient in legislation & Guidelines:

- Coverage of Data Stewardship
- Personal data protection
- Access to privately held data
- Appointment of Chief Statistician
- Position in National Administration: funding statistical programme and new work
- Other producers of Official Statistics (who to include, coverage and compliance) → flexible legislation
- Legislation → regulations/codes/guidelines (changeable)
- Access to data produced by others: more than legislation → communication, partnerships (show benefits/win-win)

- Inclusion access to privately held data
- Quality/Methodology

- Audit other producers (legal and methodological)

Statistical Open Source Software

Develop a better common understanding of the pros and cons, do's and don'ts of moving to further and more comprehensive use of open source software as a cornerstone for official statistics production, based on concrete experiences through use cases of broad interest.

Generative AI for Official Statistics

Generating content rather than assisting in tasks. Investigate further on the strategic considerations arising when statistical organisations want to use generative AI effectively and responsibly (e.g., governance, opensource models), as well as co-develop concrete solutions.



Integrating Statistical and Geospatial Data
